Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders to:

- 1. Install 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of roads as set out in the Schedule to this notice below.
- 2. Install blue badge disabled parking bays at the following locations:
  - i) Alongside No. 70 Filey Waye on Beverley Road, Ruislip
  - ii) Outside No. 2 St Mary's Walk, Hayes
  - iii) Outside No. 30 St Anne's Road, Harefield
  - iv) Outside No. 74 Bedford Avenue, Hayes
- 3. Convert the Zone HY1 permit holder parking place outside No. 25 St Anselms Road, Hayes to a blue badge disabled parking bay.
- 4. Convert a section of Zone N permit holder parking place outside No. 170 Thirlmere Gardens, Northwood to a blue badge disabled parking bay.
- 5. Convert the redundant blue badge disabled parking bay outside No. 45 Blyth Road, Hayes to Zone HY2 permit holder parking place.
- 6. Remove the following redundant disabled parking bays at the following locations:
  - i) Outside No. 111 Herlwyn Avenue, Ruislip
  - ii) Outside No. 27 Albion Road, Hayes
  - iii) Outside No. 37 Woolacombe Way, Hayes
  - iv) Outside No. 23 Petworth Gardens, Hillingdon
  - v) Outside No. 13 Westbourne Close, Haves
  - vi) Outside No. 34 Westbourne Close, Hayes
- 7. Introduce an addition no stopping school keep clear marking on Kingston Lane. West Drayton operational 'Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm' opposite Nos. 14 to 20 Kingston Lane.
- 8. Convert the existing limited time waiting restrictions in the following sections of Angel Lane, Hayes to 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions:
  - i) On the northwest side of the road between the junction with the Uxbridge Road and the boundary between No. 2 Angel Lane and The Angel PH.
  - ii) On the southeast side of the road between the junction with the Uxbridge Road to outside No. 5 Angel Lane.
- 9. Remove a section of the existing limited time waiting restrictions outside Nos. 2 and 4 Acorn Grove, Ruislip.

LEACROFT CLOSE, YIEWSLEY - At the junction adjacent to No. 1 Leacroft Close.


MILBURN DRIVE, YIEWSLEY – At the junction with Newcombe Rise.




### STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposed installation of an additional school keep clear marking, waiting and loading restrictions are intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the previous Cabinet Member for Property, Highway and Transport to proceed to formal consultation.


