
- 1. Introduce limited time waiting restrictions operational 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' on the section of Moorhall Road, Harefield between the Borough boundary with Buckinghamshire Council and the bus stops by the entrance to and opposite the The River Garden public house.
- 2. Introduce 'at any time' waiting restrictions on Moorhall Road, Harefield either side of the junctions leading to the HS2 Haul Road.

Applications to the High Court challenging the validity of these Orders should be made within six weeks of the date on which these Orders were made. - This Order shall come into operation on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2023 and may be cited as the Hillingdon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) No. 16 Experimental Order 2023.
- 2. In this Order "Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Hillingdon.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Hillingdon (Waiting & Loading Restrictions) Order 2021<sup>4</sup> shall have effect as though the item numbered 122 in Schedule 1 of that Order
