THE HILLINGDON (ON STREET PARKING PLACES) (YIEWSLEY PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME) Y ZONES (AMENDMENT NO. 1) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2024

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it made these experimental Orders under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on 19th April 2024 coming into operation on 1st May 2024 to:

- 1. Convert sections of existing limited time waiting restrictions to 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the following sections Tavistock Road, Yiewsley:
 - i) Northeast side, from a point 58 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Winnock Road, southeastwards for a distance of 45 metres.
 - ii) Northeast side, extend the existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions southeast of the junction with Winnock Road by a further 6 metres southeastwards.
 - iii) Northeast side, from a point 28 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Heathcote Way, southeastwards for a distance of 26 metres.
 - iv) Northeast side, extend the existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions northwest of the northwestern kerbline of Heathcote Way by a further 10 metres northwestwards.
- 2. Reduce the length of the following Zone Y1 permit holder parking places on Tavistock Road, Yiewsley and replace with 'at any time' waiting restrictions:
 - i) Northeast side, reduce the northwestern extent of the parking place outside No. 24 Tavistock Road by 3 metres southeastwards.
 - ii) Southwest side, reduce the northwestern extent of the parking place opposite No. 24 Tavistock Road by 3 metres southeastwards.

Further information can be obtained by email parkingmanagementschemes@hillingdon.gov.uk If the provisions of these Orders continue in operation for a period of not less than 6 months, the Council will consider in due course whether the provision of these Orders should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of Orders under Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Persons wishing to object to the making of these Orders under Section 6 of the said Act should write or email before 1st November 2024, stating grounds for objection and your home address to Transport and Projects, Place Directorate, Civic Centre, Uxbridge, Middlesex UB8 1UW quoting reference 3N/04/15220/24/04/2024. Applications to the High Court challenging the validity of these Orders should be made within six weeks of the date on which these Orders were made.



- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order as The Hillingdon (On Street Parking Places) (Yiewsley Parking Management Scheme) Y Zones Order 2024⁴ shall have effect as though the parking places numbered 35 and 40 in Schedule 2 of that Order were substituted by the parking places numbered the same as set out in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 3. In pursuance of Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Head of Transport & Town Centre Projects of the London Borough of Hillingdon, for the time being, or some other person authorised in that behalf by him, may, if it appears to him or that person essential in the interests of the

SCHEDULE 2

RESIDENT PERMIT HOLDERS PARKING PLACES - ZONE Y1

In relation to the parking place referred to in this schedule, the expression "permitted hours," means the period between 'Monday to Saturday 9am to 6pm' inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday. Parking places in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone Y1 permit or visitor voucher or has been granted either a virtual residents permit or virtual visitor voucher. All parking places are 2 metres wide unless otherwise stated.
