

Fire Safety: Do you need support? Please let us know

Why This Matters

Your safety is our priority. If you live in a high-rise building and have a physical, sensory, or mental health condition that may affect your ability to respond to a fire emergency, we want to hear from you.

We know that some residents have underlying issues which will need to be discussed and considered by your Tenancy Management Officer as part of a plan to support you:

- Personal Emergency Plans: This 'PEP' will record what measures need to be put in place for or by you to reduce the potential for a fire starting, to ensure you have effective early warning of a fire starting and to ensure that you act appropriately once a fire is discovered.
- Personal Emergency Evacuation Plans: This 'PEEP' will be developed where we identify residents who are unable to self-evacuate from the building unaided. Where this is the case, we will work with them and others who may support or live with them.

These are reviewed each year or following a material change in circumstances.

However, we need to hear from you if you are not currently part of a plan outlined above and may need additional support or adjustments to stay safe in the event of a fire.
