Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders to **remove the following sections of permit holder parking places to facilitate the installation of new vehicle crossings:**

- ii) Remove sections of the Zone N permit holder parking place outside Nos. 21 and 23 Moor Park Road, Northwood and replace with 'Monday to Friday 1pm to 2pm' waiting restrictions.
- iii) Remove the entire Zone Y2 permit holder parking place outside No. 2 Gordon Road, Yiewsley and replace with 'Monday to Friday 8.30am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.
- iv) Remove a section of the Zone U5 business permit holder parking place outside No. 1a Villier Street, Uxbridge and replace with 'at any time' waiting restrictions.
- v) Remove a section of the Zone H1 permit holder parking place outside No. 46 Doghurst Avenue, Hayes and replace with '9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.
- vi) Remove a section of the Zone SR permit holder parking place outside No. 63 Great Central Avenue, Ruislip and replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions. Convert the redundant disabled parking place outside No. 61 Great Central Avenue to Zone SR permit holder parking.
- vii) Remove the entire Zone SR permit holder parking place outside No. 25 Masson Avenue, Ruislip and replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.
- viii) Remove the entire Zone U5 permit holder parking place outside No. 89 Manor Waye, Uxbridge and replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.

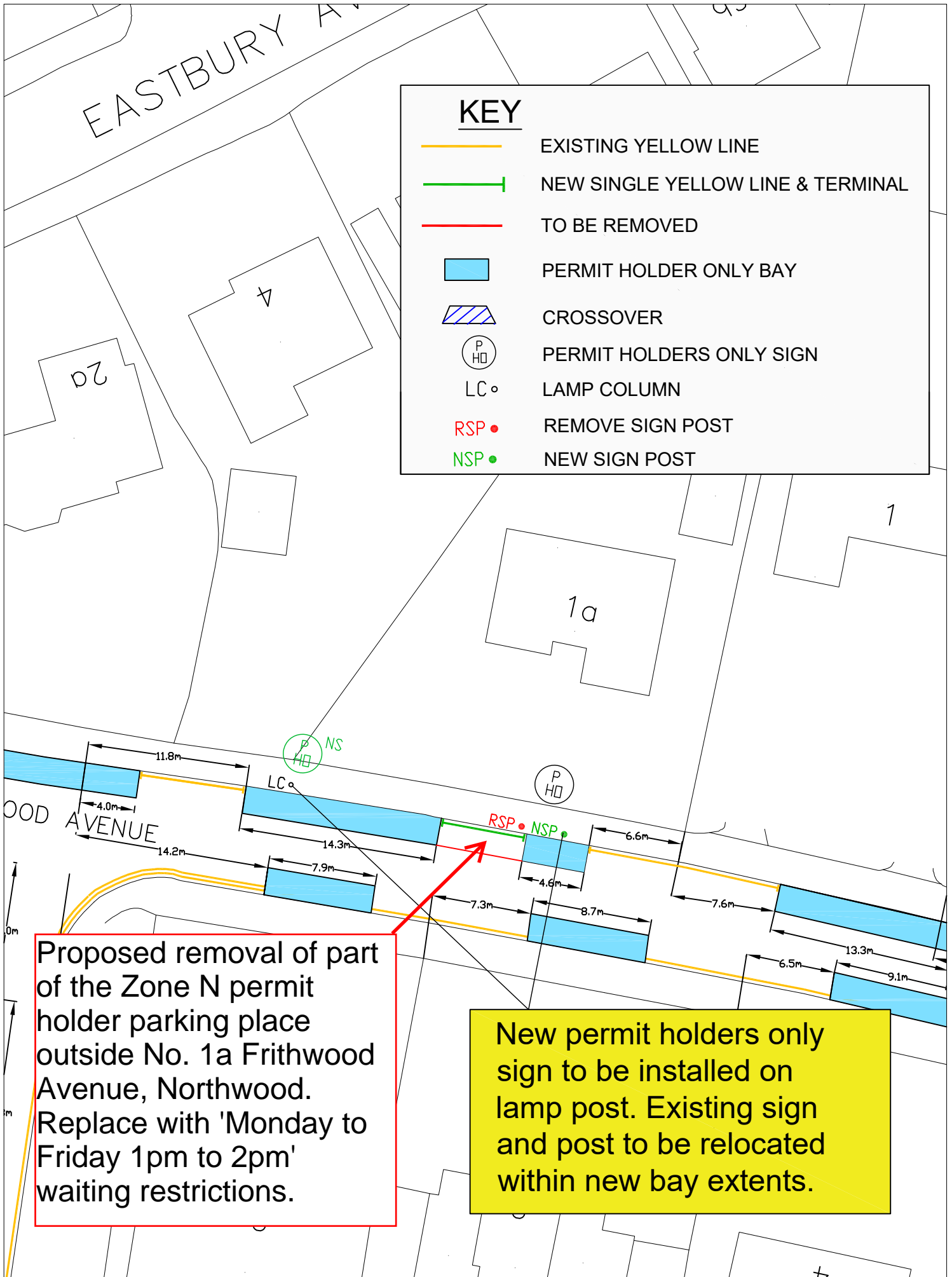

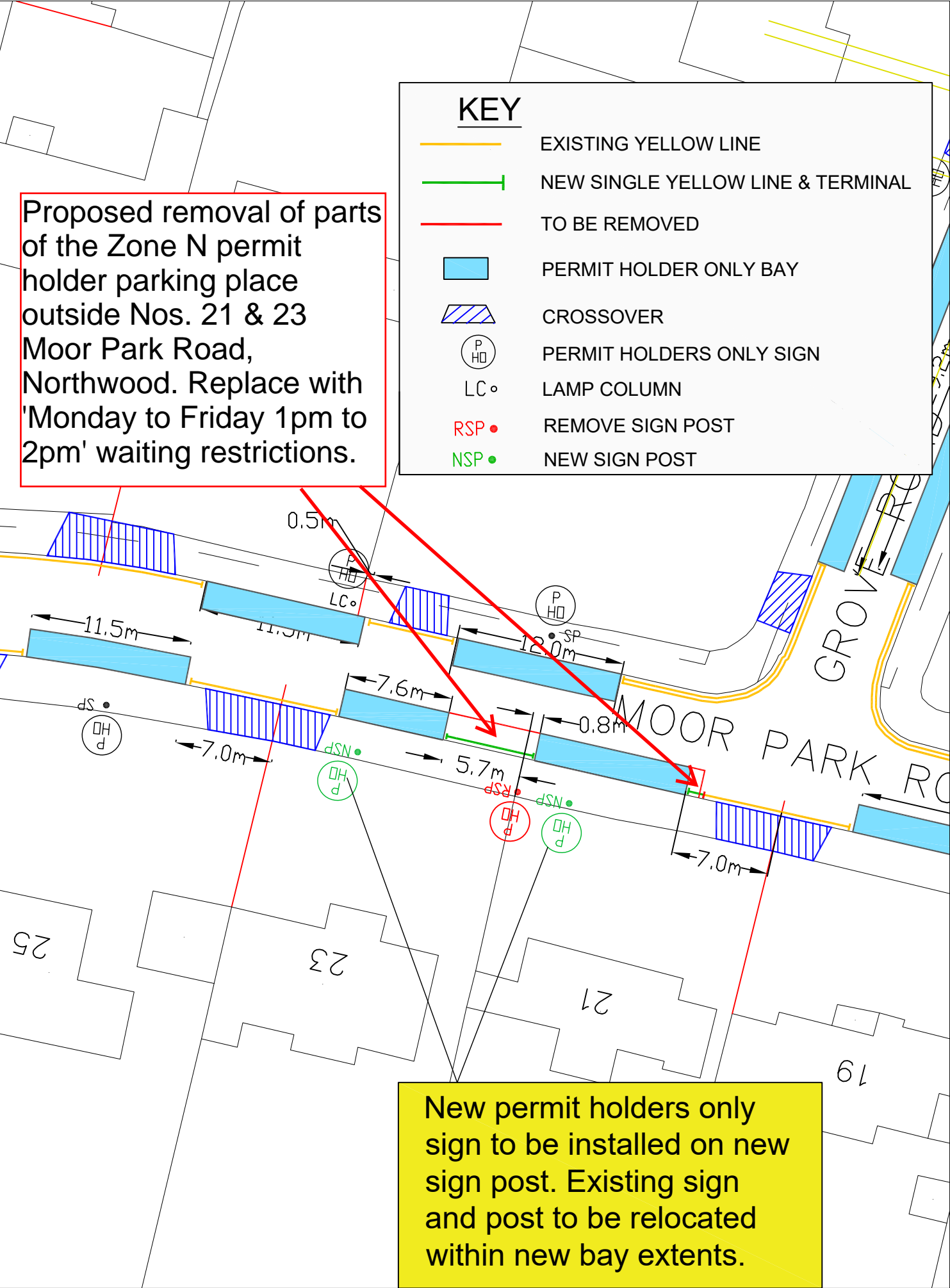

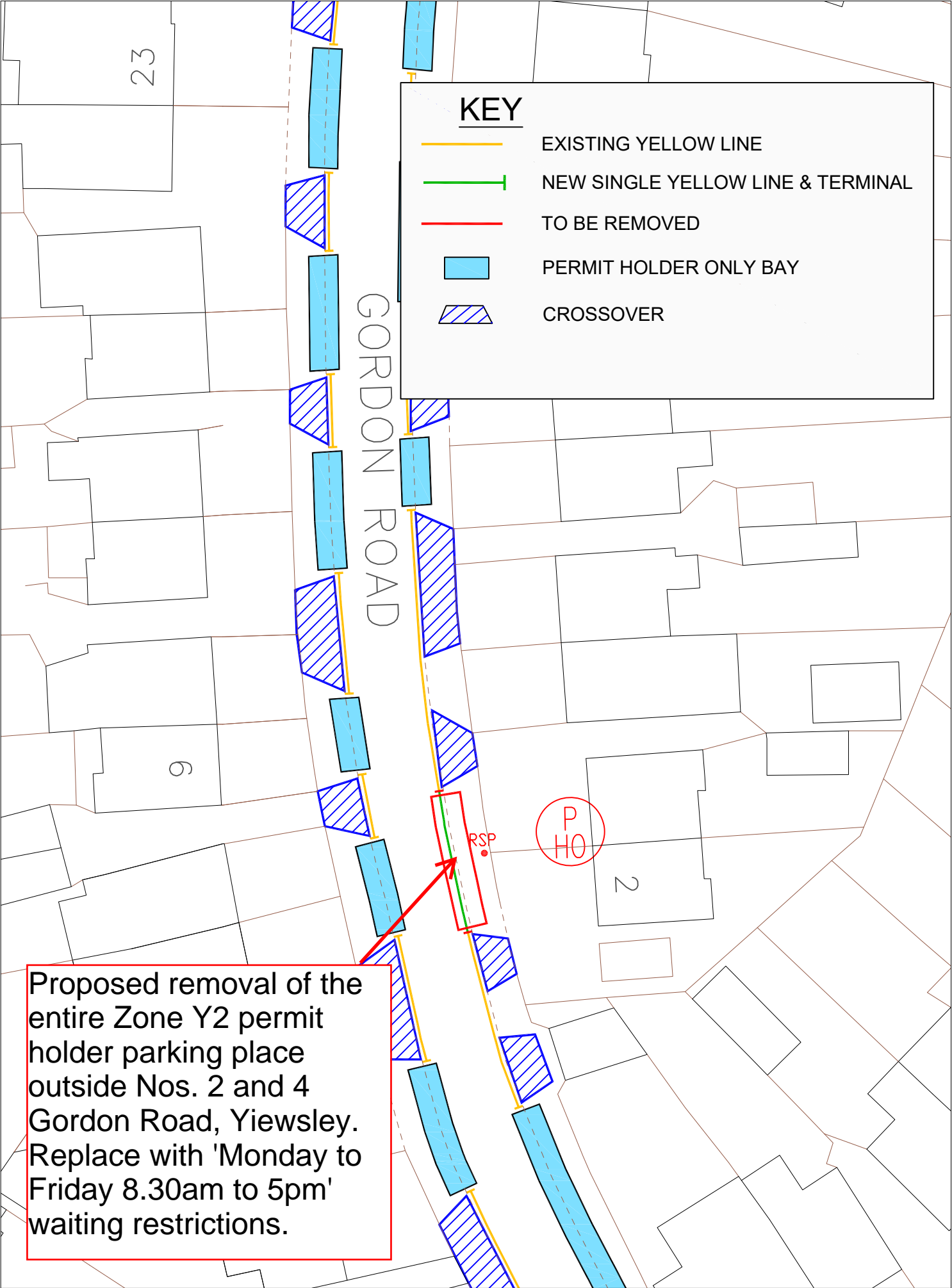
Amendments to accommodate a new vehicle crossover



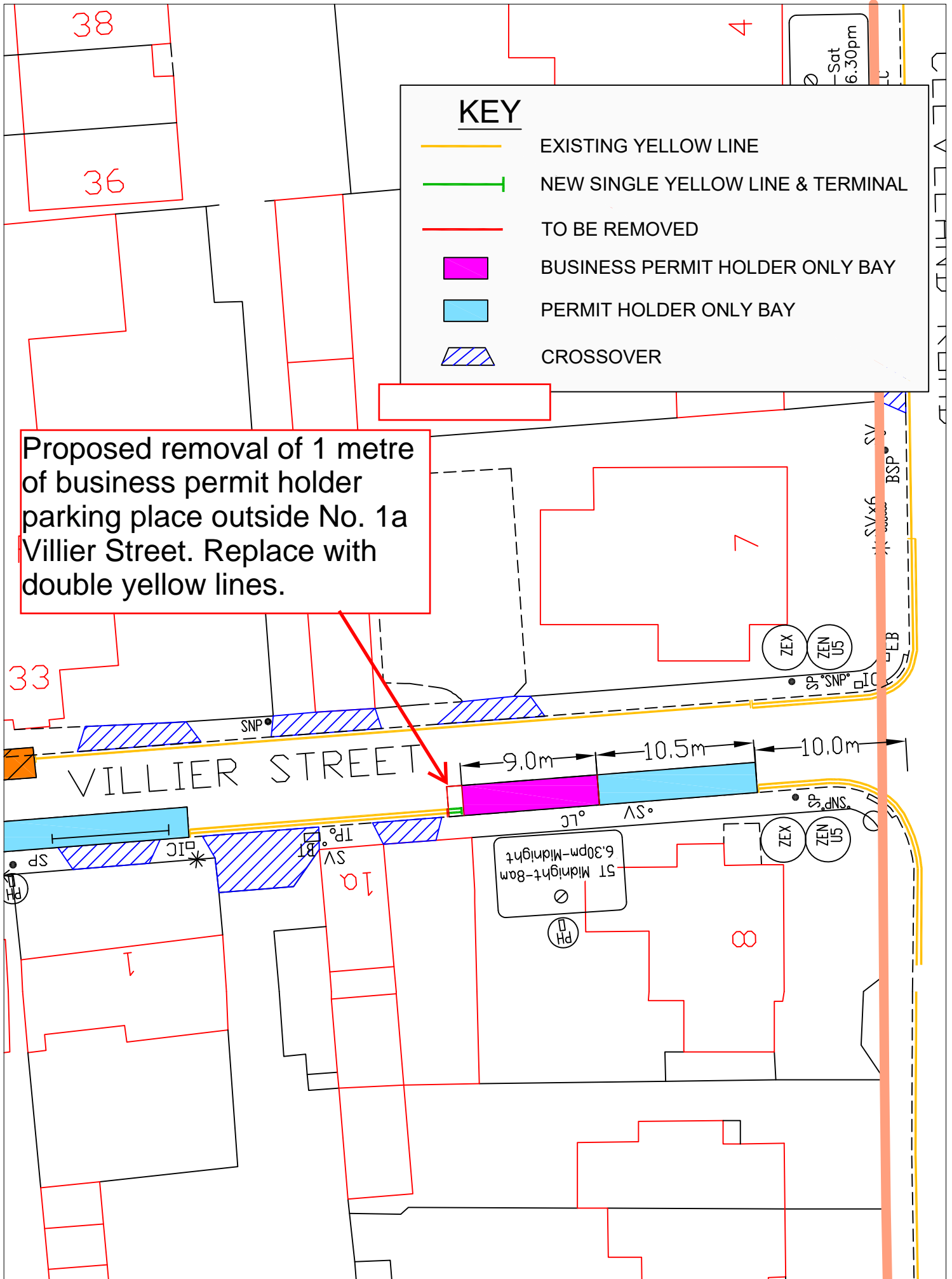
21 & 23 Moor Park Road, Northwood - Amendments to accommodate new vehicle crossovers



2 Gordon Road, Yiewsley - Amendments to accommodate a new vehicle crossing

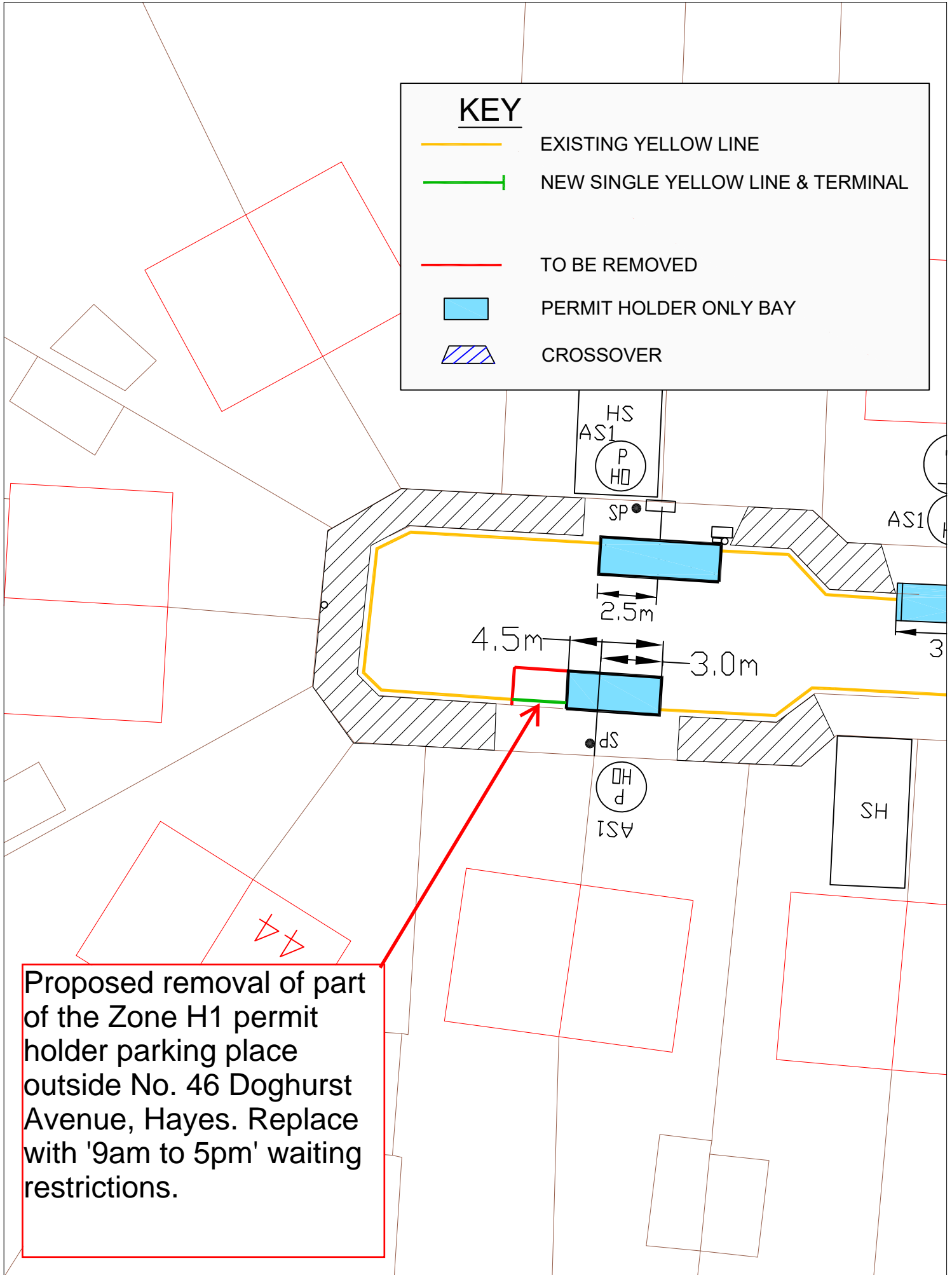


1a Villier Street, Uxbridge - Amendments to accommodate a vehicle crossing extension

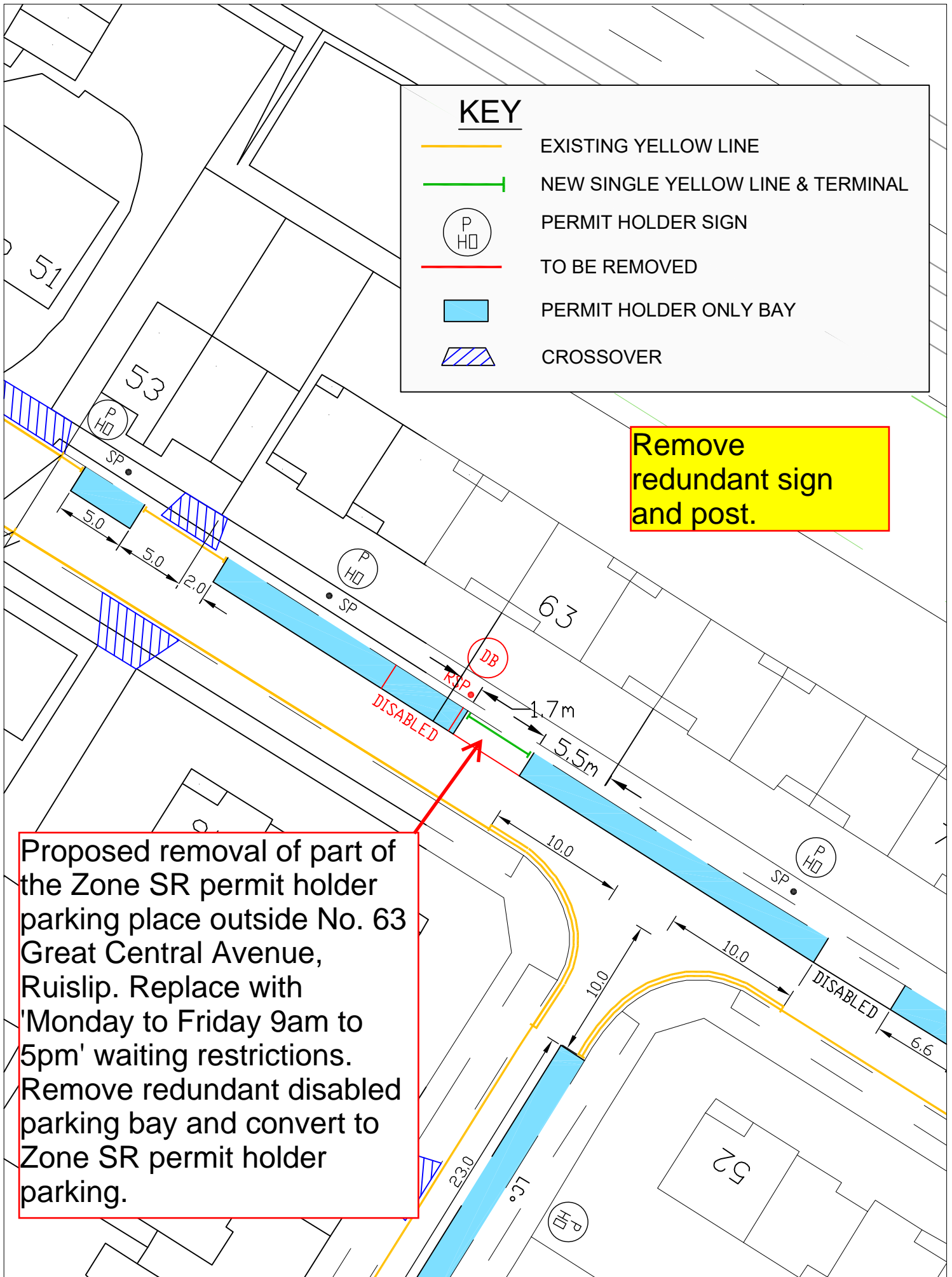


46 Doghurst Avenue, Hayes

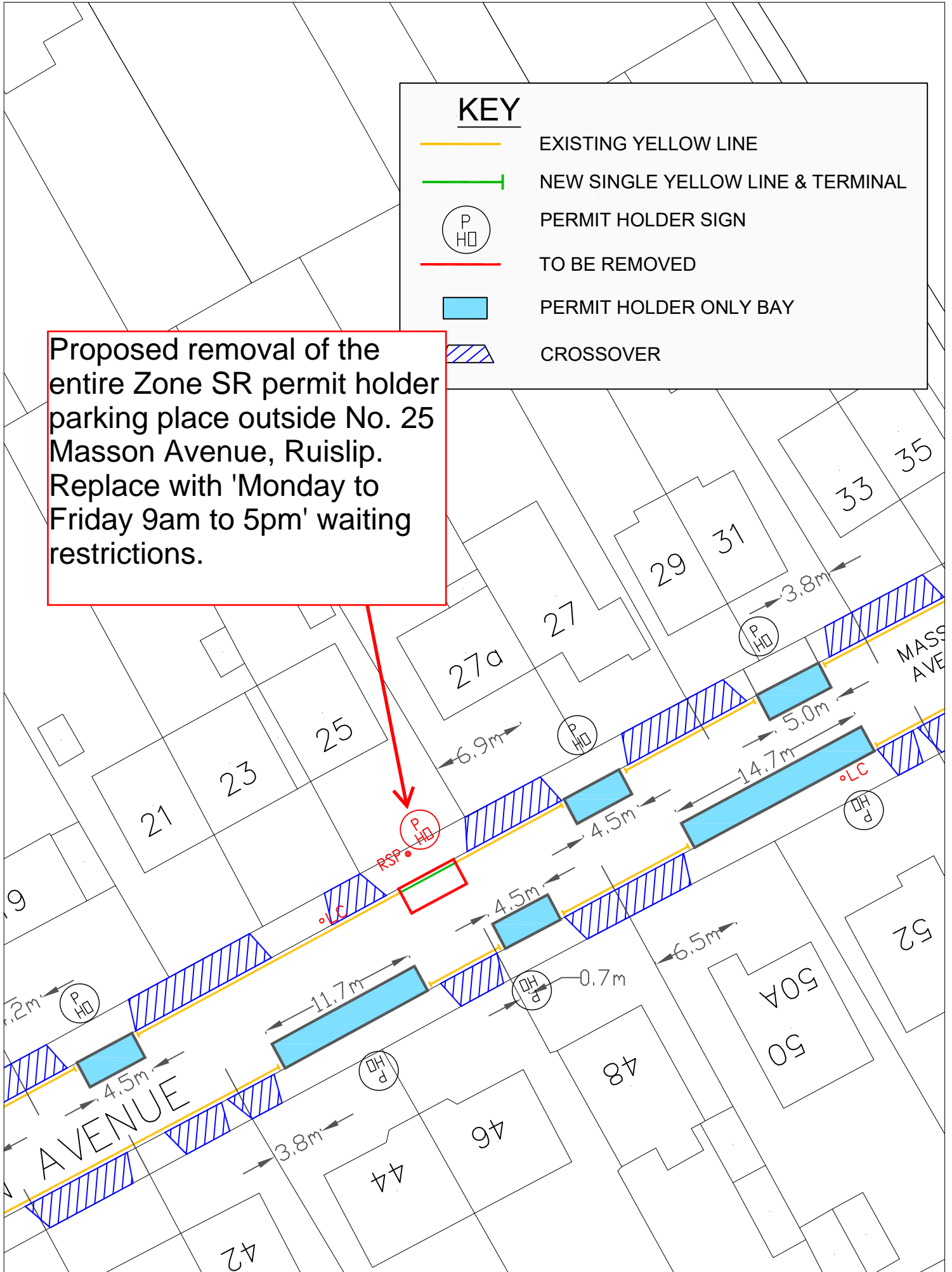
Amendments for a vehicle crossing extension



63 Great Central Avenue, Ruislip - Amendments to accommodate a new vehicle crossing

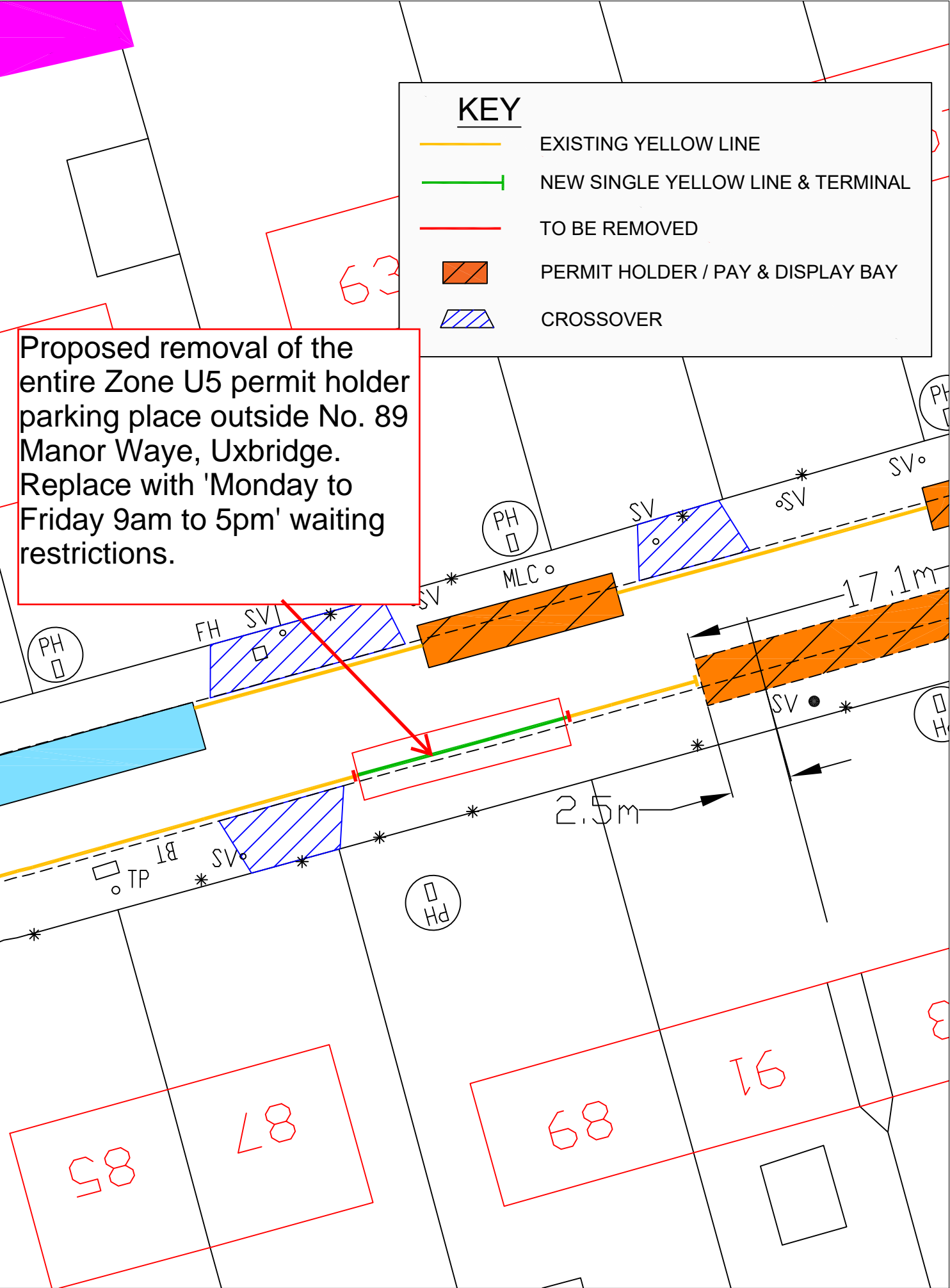


25 Masson Avenue, Ruislip - Amendments to accommodate a new vehicle crossing
