Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders which will **introduce a Stop &**Shop parking scheme outside Yeading Lane / Willow Tree Lane, Hayes shopping parade with the following operational aspects:

- 1) Install Goods Vehicle loading only bays operational 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' in which a Goods Vehicle may load and unload for up to 20 minutes within the following parts of the service road:
 - i) Outside Nos. 3 to 7 Willow Tree Lane, Hayes
 - ii) Outside Nos. 248 and 250 Yeading Lane, Hayes
 - iii) Outside No. 266 Yeading Lane, Hayes
- 2) Install a Blue Badge Disabled Bay within the service road outside No. 236 Yeading Lane, Hayes operational 'at any time'.
- 3) Install Pay & Display parking bays operational 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' along the following sections of the service road with charges tabulated below:
 - i) Install four Pay & Display parking bays between No. 234 Yeading Lane and No. 3 Willow Tree Lane, Haves.
 - ii) Install eight Pay & Display parking bays between Nos. 238 and 248 Yeading Lane, Hayes.
 - iii) Install seven Pay & Display parking bays between Nos. 252 and 264 Yeading Lane, Hayes.
- 4) Install sections of double yellow lines along the following sections of the service road, replacing any existing waiting restrictions:
 - i) Around the southeastern extremity of the service road, next to No. 7 Willow Tree Lane, Hayes.
 - ii) Opposite Nos. 1 to 7 Willow Tree Lane and Nos. 234 to 346 Yeading Lane, Hayes.
 - iii) Opposite the junction with Dunedin Way, Hayes to a point opposite Melbourne House, Yeading Lane, Hayes.
 - iv) Across the informal crossing point outside No. 234/236 Yeading Lanes, Hayes.
 - v) Across the access between Nos. 264 and 266 Yeading Lane, Hayes.
 - vi) Between the edge of the loading bay outside No. 266 Yeading Lane and the junction with Dunedin Way.
 - vii) On the southwest side of Dunedin Way, Hayes where it meets the service road.
- 5) Revoke all provisions to allow parking on the footway within the service road.
