Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Install 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of roads as set out in the schedule to this notice below.
- 2. Remove 7.3 metres of 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' loading restrictions opposite Nos. 1 and 3 Keith Road, Hayes.
- 3. Install 'Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm' waiting restrictions between the proposed double yellow lines near Nos. 43 and 45 up to the existing school keep clear markings outside Rosedale College, Wood End Green Road, Hayes.
- 4. Revise the previously proposed limited time waiting restrictions advertised on 10th July 2019 along sections of St John's Road, Uxbridge between the junction with St John's Close and the junction with Cowley Mill Road to operate between the times of 'Monday to Friday 1pm to 2pm'.
- 5. Install blue badge disabled parking bays at the following locations:
 - i) Adjacent to No. 72 Brackenbridge Drive, Ruislip on White Butts Road
 - ii) Outside No. 104 Wentworth Crescent, Hayes
 - iii) Adjacent to No. 4 Haig Cottages, Uxbridge Road, Hillingdon on Marlborough Road
 - iv) Adjacent to No. 109 Charnwood Road, Hillingdon on Ashdown Road
- 6. Remove the following redundant blue badge disabled parking bays:
 - i) Outside No. 22 Azalea Walk, Eastcote
 - ii) Outside No. 79 Bletchmore Close, Harlington
 - iii) Outside No. 24 Hughes Road, Hayes
 - iv) Outside No. 77 Addison Way, Northwood

7. Convert the Zone H1 permit holder parking place to a disabled bay in Pinglestone Close alongside No. 358 Bath Road, West Drayton.

SCHEDULE

PROPOSED 'AT ANY TIME' WAITING RESTRICTIONS

STRONE WAY, HAYES - Between the junctions with Broadmead Road and Darris Close. DARRIS CLOSE, HAYES - At the junction with Strone Way, outside No. 1 Darris Close. KEITH ROAD, HAYES - Convert a section of single yellow line opposite Nos. 1 to 5 Keith Road. COLLINGWOOD ROAD, HILLINGDON - Outside Nos. 54 to 60, southeast of the junction with Westbourne Road.

WOOD END GREEN ROAD, HAYES - Extend the existing double yellow lines near the junction with Leven Way adjacent to Nos. 39 and 41 Wood End Green Road.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed installation of waiting and loading restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.

The revised proposals to introduce limited time waiting restrictions along St John's Road, Uxbridge takes into account the views of local residents who commented during the previous formal consultation.

The proposed disabled parking bays are intended to benefit disabled people by providing parking bays for the sole use of "blue badge" holders. Redundant bays will be removed to provide more parking for residents and their visitors.
