

- 8. Remove the following redundant blue badge disabled parking bays:
 - i) Outside No. 3 Ashwood Gardens, Hayes
 - ii) Outside No. 5 Maygoods Green, Cowley
 - iii) Outside No. 18 Waltham Avenue, Hayes
 - iv) Outside No. 3 Cambrook Court, Camden Avenue, Hayes
 - v) Outside No. 46 Moorfield Road, Uxbridge

SCHEDULE PROPOSED 'AT ANY TIME' WAITING RESTRICTIONS

KEWFERRY ROAD, NORTHWOOD - Extend the existing double yellow lines outside No. 2 Kewferry Road, northeastwards.

TREETOPS CLOSE, NORTHWOOD - Extend the existing double yellow lines along the entire southwest side of the road.

TUDOR ROAD, HAYES - At the junction between Nos. 69 and 71 Tudor Road leading to the garages. RAYNTON DRIVE, HAYES - At the junction with Raynton Close.

RAYNTON CLOSE, HAYES - At the junction with Raynton Drive, extending further on the northeast side adjacent to No. 29a Raynton Drive.

MIDHURST GARDENS, HILLINGDON

- i) On the inside of the corner opposite Nos. 50 to 68 Midhurst Gardens.

PARKFIELD CRESCENT, RUISLIP - Around all sides of the central island outside Nos. 29 to 49 Parkfield Crescent.

HALLOWELL ROAD, NORTHWOOD - Across the access leading to Forge Lane and the northern entrance to the St. Matthews Church Hall.

TORCROSS ROAD, RUISLIP - Extend the existing double yellow lines outside No. 58 Torcross Road by 2.2 metres.

BRIDLE ROAD, EASTCOTE - At the junction with Rushdene Road.

RUSHDENE ROAD, EASTCOTE - At the junction with Bridle Road.

EAST MEAD, RUISLIP - At the junction with Mount Pleasant.

MOUNT PLEASANT, RUISLIP - At the junction with East Mead.

ALANDALE DRIVE, NORTHWOOD - At the junction with Valley Close.

VALLEY CLOSE, NORTHWOOD - At the junction with Alandale Drive.

OAKWOOD ROAD, PINNER - At the junction with Hazelwood Drive.

STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposed installation of waiting and loading restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.

The proposed installation of school keep clear restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety.

The proposed installation of a loading bay is to facilitate a suitable provision for local businesses.


The proposed disabled parking bays are intended to benefit disabled people by providing parking bays for the sole use of "blue badge" holders. Redundant bays will be removed to provide more parking for residents and their visitors.




Junction Hallowell Road / High Street Proposed Loading Restrictions








o/s 7a, 9 & 9a Grove Road Proposed Waiting Restrictions





