Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Install 'at any time' waiting restrictions on sections of road as set out in the schedule to this notice.
- 2. Revise the previously proposed extension to the Cowley Parking Management Scheme Zone C3 in Verona Close and Sefton Way, Cowley:
 - i) Remove the previously proposed Zone C3 permit holder parking place south of No. 100 Verona Close, replace with double yellow lines.
 - ii) Install double yellow lines at the junction of Sefton Way and Fernes Close, extending up to the junction with High Road Cowley.
- 3. Convert the existing single yellow lines at the junction of St Martins Approach and Moat Drive. Ruislip to double yellow lines and extend the restrictions on St Martins Approach either side of the junction.
- 4. Rationalise the existing Zone E2 definition of residents within the Eastcote Parking Management Scheme Zone E2 Traffic Management Order.
- 5. Convert the disabled parking bay outside No. 10 St John's Close, Uxbridge to Zone UM parking place.

SCHEDULE PROPOSED 'AT ANY TIME' WAITING RESTRICTIONS


VIOLET AVENUE, HILLINGDON - Extend the existing double yellow lines west of the junction with Myrtle Close by 9.5 metres up to where footway parking begins.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed installation of waiting restrictions and loading restrictions are intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety.

The rationalisation of the Zone E2 definition of residents within the Eastcote Parking Management Scheme will ensure a new development is not entitled to apply for parking permits.

The proposed amendments to Parking Management Schemes proposed in Sefton Way and Verona Close, Cowley and St John's Close, Uxbridge are recommended as a result of comments made residents by during the previous formal consultation. These amendments are intended to enable residents to maximise the benefits that these parking schemes provide.
