- 1. Establish permit parking places (operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone SR permit in the sections of roads set out in the Schedule to this notice.
- 2. Introduce waiting restrictions operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' with sections of double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking within sections of the roads as set out in the Schedule to this notice.
- 3. Extend the operational times of the South Ruislip Parking Management Scheme Zone SR throughout all of Rydal Way, Ruislip to operate '9am to 9pm everyday'.
- 4. Extend the operating times of the permit holder parking places that form part of the Ruislip Parking Management Scheme Zone R2 outside Nos. 2 to 10 Sharps Lane and Nos. 1 to 9 Bury Street, Ruislip to '8am to 10pm everyday'.
- 5. Formalise all existing sections of single yellow line outside Nos. 2 to 10 Sharps Lane to operate 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' in line with the rest of the scheme.
- 6. Remove part of the Zone SR permit holder parking place outside No. 14a Manor Gardens, Ruislip and replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.

**RESIDENTS PERMITS** - £0 - 1st vehicle, all subsequent - £40 per annum.

**VISITORS VOUCHERS** - First book of 10 per household per annum- free. £5 - per book of 10 thereafter.
