Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of road as set out in the Schedule of this notice.
- 2. Impose 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' waiting restrictions in the rear access road behind Nos. 388 398 Long Lane. Hillingdon.
- 3. Impose 'Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm' waiting restrictions in Avondale Drive, Hayes on the northeast side of the road between the existing double yellow lines between the junctions with Coldharbour Lane. Cotmans Close & Hitherbroom Road.
- 4. Remove the Zone N permit holder parking place outside No. 2 Drysdale Close, Northwood and replace with 'Monday to Friday 1pm to 2pm' waiting restrictions.
- 5. Install blue badge disabled parking bays at the following locations:
 - i) Opposite No. 43 Hilliard Road, Northwood
 - ii) Outside No. 68 Monmouth Road, Hayes
 - iii) Outside No. 94a Seaton Gardens, Ruislip
 - iv) Outside No. 90 Botwell Common Road, Hayes
 - v) Outside No. 126 Clyfford Road, Ruislip
- 6. Convert the Zone SR permit holder parking place outside Nos. 28b Edwards Avenue, Ruislip to a blue badge disabled parking bay.
- 7. Remove the following redundant blue badge disabled parking bays:
 - i) Outside No. 244 Whitby Road, Ruislip
 - ii) Outside No. 7 Ash Grove, Hayes
 - iii) Outside No. 33 Bryony Close, Uxbridge
 - iv) Outside No. 35 Granville Road, Hayes
 - v) Outside No. 14 Kingston Lane, West Drayton
 - vi) Outside No. 61 Great Central Avenue, South Ruislip (convert to permit holder parking)
- 8. Extend the length of Zone U1 permit holder parking place at the southern end of Braybourne Close, Uxbridge near the junction with High Street and install a passing place within the middle of the existing space to ensure access is not compromised.
- 9. Install an additional Zone U1 permit holder parking place in the section of Braybourne Close, Uxbridge between Nos. 65 and 66.

SCHEDULE 1 - Proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions

CENTRAL AVENUE, HAYES - All sides of the roundabout at the junction with Townfield Road. TOWNFIELD ROAD, HAYES - All sides of the roundabout at the junction with Central Avenue. FIELD END ROAD, RUISLIP - West side, between the zebra crossing and bus stop north of Brackenhill. PORTMAN GADENS, UXBRIDGE - The junction between Nos. 4 and 12 Portman Gardens. SOUTHBOURNE GARDENS, EASTCOTE - Southwest of the junction with Mansfield Avenue. HARLINGTON ROAD, HILLINGDON - The southern most arm of the service road fronting Nos. 305-387 Harlington Road.

GLEDWOOD DRIVE, HAYES - Extend the existing double yellow lines to outside Nos. 47 and 49 Gledwood Drive.

HILLSIDE ROAD, NORTHWOOD - Extend the existing double yellow lines west of the junction with Potter Street Hill by 20 meters.

LABURNUM ROAD, HAYES - At the junction with Roseville Road.

ROSEVILLE ROAD, HAYES - At the junction with Laburnum Road.

RIVER CLOSE, EASTCOTE - Extend the existing double yellow lines on the southeast side near the junction with Elmbridge Drive by 21.7 metres.

ST MARTIN'S APPROACH, RUISLIP - Extend the existing double yellow lines on both sides of the road north of the junction with Pinn Way by 10 metres.


STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposed installation of waiting restrictions and removal of a section of permit holder parking bay is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.


The proposed disabled parking bays are intended to benefit disabled people by providing parking bays for the sole use of "blue badge" holders. Redundant bays will be removed to provide more parking for residents and their visitors.

The proposed amendments to the Parking Management Scheme in Braybourne Close, Uxbridge are intended to provide additional parking for residents and their visitors whilst still ensuring clear access throughout the road is maintained.


