- 2. Establish permit parking places in Myrtleside Close, Northwood (operational 'Monday to Saturday 10am to 11am and 3pm to 4pm') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone N permit.
- 3. Establish permit parking places in Gateway Close, Northwood (operational 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone N permit.
- 4. Introduce waiting restrictions operational between 'Monday to Friday 1pm to 2pm' with sections of double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking within sections of the roads as set out in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- 5. Introduce waiting restrictions operational between 'Monday to Saturday 10am to 11am and 3pm to 4pm' in Myrtleside Close, Northwood.
- 6. Introduce waiting restrictions operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' in Gateway Close, Northwood.
- 7. Introduce 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the sections of road as set out in Schedule 2 to this notice.
- 8. Introduce a permit holders past this point residents' parking scheme in Treetops Close, Northwood operational between 'Monday to Friday 1pm and 2pm' in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone N permit or visitor voucher.
- 9. Introduce a Stop & Shop parking scheme in the lay-by areas outside Nos. 6 to 72 High Street, Northwood with the following operational aspects:
 - i) Establish Pay & Display parking bays operational 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' with a maximum stay of up to 4 hours.
 - ii) Install sections of 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' waiting restrictions.
 - iii) Introduce a Blue Badge disabled parking bay outside No. 20/22 High Street, Northwood.






The proposed extension to the Northwood Parking Management Scheme is intended to prevent all day non-residential parking and promote road safety.


