Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Establish permit parking places (operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone C2 permit in the sections of roads set out in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- 2. Establish permit parking places (operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone C3 permit in the sections of roads set out in Schedule 2 to this notice.
- 3. Impose waiting restrictions operational between "Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' with sections of double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking within sections of the roads as set out in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice.
- 4. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the sections of road as set out in Schedule 3 to this notice.
- 5. Remove the following sections of permit holder parking places to facilitate the installation of new vehicle crossings:
 - i) Outside No. 91 Whitehall Road, Uxbridge
 - ii) Outside No. 55 Hudson Road, Harlington
 - iii) Outside No. 59 Dellfield Crescent, Cowley
 - iv) Outside No. 76 Dellfield Crescent, Cowley

RESIDENTS PERMITS - £0 - 1st vehicle, all subsequent - £40 per annum.

VISITORS VOUCHERS - First book of 10 per household per annum- free. £5 - per book of 10 thereafter. Copies of the notice of proposals, proposed Orders together with full details, plans and the Council's statement of reasons for the proposals can be seen at Harlington, Uxbridge and Yiewsley libraries and by appointment at, Civic Centre, Uxbridge during normal office hours until 28th November 2018. BIKO CLOSE, COWLEY FERNES CLOSE, COWLEY SEFTON WAY, COWLEY VERONA CLOSE, COWLEY


SCHEDULE 3 - Proposed double yellow lines

PEACHEY CLOSE, COWLEY - North side, east of the junction with New Peachey Lane.


STATEMENT OF REASONS
