1. Introduce 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of various roads as set out in the Schedule to this notice.

2. Introduce a 30 minute time limit on Blue Badge holders parking within the permit holder parking places that for part of the Ruislip Lido Parking Management Scheme Zone RL2. 3. Install blue badge disabled parking bays at the following locations:

- i) Opposite No. 16 Turnstone Close, Ickenham.
- ii) Outside No. 2-6 Cedar House, Larch Crescent, Hayes.
- iii) Outside No. 29 Charnwood Road, Hillingdon.
- iv) Alongside No. 122 Tudor Road, Hayes.
- v) Outside No. 33 Thornton Avenue, West Drayton.
- vi) Outside No. 129 Heather Lane, West Drayton.
- vii) Outside No. 379 Harlington Road, Hayes (main service road).
- viii) Outside No. 12E High Street, Harefield,

4. Remove the following redundant blue badge disabled parking bays:

- i) Outside No. 366 West End Road, Ruislip
- ii) Outside No. 28 Park Way, Ruislip

5. Convert the existing single yellow line on Withy Lane, Ruislip between No. 28 Withy Lane and Rotary House to double yellow lines.

6. Convert the existing singe yellow lines on Colham Mill Road, West Drayton from the junction with Station Road to outside No. 2 Colham Mill Road and adjacent to Carter House. 7. Establish permit parking places (operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone UM permit in St John's Close and Lambourne Court, Uxbridge.

8. Introduce waiting restrictions operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' with sections of double vellow lines to prevent obstructive parking in St John's Close and Lambourne Court, Uxbridge.

9. Designate the sections footway as shared use for cyclists and pedestrians in Springfield Road and Beaconsfield Road, Hayes.

10. Install a zebra crossing on Springfield Road, Hayes north of the junction with Bullsbrook Road.

11. Install a zebra crossing on Beaconsfield Road, Hayes east of the junction with Springfield Road outside Guru Nanak Sikh Primary School.

12. Propose a permit holders past this point residents' parking scheme in Farm Close. Ickenham operational between 'Monday to Friday 9am and 5pm' in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone IC permit or visitor voucher. **RESIDENTS PERMITS** - £0 - 1st vehicle, all subsequent - £40 per annum.

VISITORS VOUCHERS - First book of 10 per household per annum- free, £5 - per book of 10 thereafter. GRANVILLE ROAD, HAYES - At the junction with Wyre Grove.

WYRE GROVE, HAYES - At the junction with Granville Road.

ASHBURTON ROAD, RUISLIP - At the junction with Torrington Road.

TORRINGTON ROAD, RUISLIP - At the junction with Ashburton Road.

BROADWOOD AVENUE, RUISLIP - Outside Nos. 92 and 93 Broadwood Avenue on approach to the roundabout.

DERWENT AVENUE, ICKNEHAM - At the junction with Swakeleys Road.

AYLSHAM DRIVE, ICKENHAM - On the corner outside Nos. 187 to 257 and opposite Nos. 259 to 329 Aylsham Drive.

HONEYCROFT HILL, UXBRIDGE - Extend the existing double yellow lines from the entrance of the TA Centre up to the existing double yellow lines near the junction with Park Road.

GROSVENOR CRESCENT, HILLINGTON - On the southwestern side of the junction with Leybourne Road.

LEYBOURNE ROAD, HILLINGDON - On the southwestern side of the junction with Grosvenor Crescent. MORELLO AVENUE, HILLINGDON - Extend the existing double yellow lines outside No. 2 Morello Avenue by 8.3 metres.

WINDSOR AVENUE, HILLINGDON - Extend the existing double yellow lines outside No. 122 Windsor Avenue by 2.5 metres.

NEW ROAD, HILLINGDON - At the junction with West Drayton Road.

WEST DRAYTON ROAD, HILLINGDON - At the junction with New Road.

LONG LANE, HILLINGDON - Service road fronting Nos. 2 - 22 Long Lane, northeast side of the parking area opposite Nos. 14-18 Long Lane.

RYEFIELD AVENUE, HILLINGDON - Extend the existing double yellow lines outside No. 130 Ryefield Avenue.

MORGAN'S LANE, HAYES - Across the access next to No. 2 Morgan's Lane.

HIGH STREET, HAREFIELD - Across the frontage of No. 35 High Street.

EIGHTH AVENUE, HAYES - Along both sides of the narrow section of road outside Nos. 1 to 8 Eighth Avenue.

BUSHEY ROAD, ICKENHAM

- i) At the junction with Hoylake Crescent.
- ii) At the junction with Chiltern Close.

HOYLAKE CRESCENT, ICKENHAM - At the junction with Bushey Road.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed installation of waiting restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.


The proposed disabled parking bays are intended to benefit disabled people by providing parking bays for the sole use of "blue badge" holders. Redundant bays will be removed to provide more parking for residents and their visitors.


The proposed amendments to the Ickenham Parking Management Scheme will enable residents to maximise the benefits of the upcoming extension to the scheme which will be implemented shortly.


The proposed introduction of a time limit for Blue Badge holders in the roads close to Ruislip Lido will ensure parking spaces are available to residents and that a provision remains for Blue Badge holders to wait for a period of up to 30 minutes within these spaces.

The proposed introduction of a Parking Management Scheme in St John's Close and Lambourne Court, Uxbridge is intended to prevent all day non-residential parking addressing concerns raised by residents.

The proposed zebra crossing is intended to enhance road safety on Beaconsfield Road and Springfield Road, Hayes close to Guru Nanak School and improve road safety for all but in particular for those travelling to and from the school.









