Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of road as set out in the Schedule of this notice.
- 2. Rationalise the existing 7.5 tonne weight limit in Angel Lane, Hayes.
- 3. Remove 3.5 metres of Zone SR permit holder parking place outside No. 22 The Croft, Ruislip.
- 4. Install an additional Zone IC permit holder parking place on High Road, Ickenham within the service road fronting The Pump adjacent to the pond, Ickenham operational '9am to 7pm everyday'. Extend existing single yellow line northwest of the above parking place up to the existing waiting restrictions on the southeast side of the main carriageway.
- 5. Remove the following sections of permit holder parking places to facilitate the installation of new vehicle crossings:
 - i) Remove the entire Zone HE parking place outside No. 57 Hewens Road, Hayes, replace with 'Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm' waiting restrictions.
 - ii) Remove part of the Zone U5 parking place outside No. 49 Manor Waye, Uxbridge, replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.
 - iii) Remove the entire Zone IC parking place outside No. 21 Long Lane, Ickenham, replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm and Saturdays 10am to Midday' waiting restrictions.
 - iv) Remove the entire Zone HY2 parking place outside No. 116 Nestles Avenue, Hayes, replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.


STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposed removal of sections of permit holder parking places outside No. 57 Hewens Road, Hayes, No. 49 Manor Waye, Uxbridge, No. 21 Long Lane, Ickenham and No. 116 Nestles Avenue, Hayes is intended to provide clear access to soon to be created off-street parking areas.

The rationalisation of the existing 7.5 tonne weight limit in Angel Lane, Hayes is to provide clarity of the current weight limit that is in place.


The proposed installation of an additional permit holder parking place within the service road fronting The Pump will provide additional parking for residents.


The proposed installation of waiting restrictions and removal of a section of permit holder parking place outside No. 22 The Croft, Ruislip is intended to prevent obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.





