SCHEDULE - Proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions

COLERIDGE WAY, HAYES

Northeast side,

i) From a point in line with the southeastern kerbline of Warley Road, to a point opposite a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 686 and 688/690 Uxbridge Road.


ii) From a point opposite a point 1 metre southeast of the common boundary of Nos. 678/680 and 682/684 Uxbridge Road, to a point in line with the northwestern kerbline of Shakespear Avenue. *Southwest side.*

SCHEDULE 1 - Proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions

FORE STREET, EASTCOTE - Proposed extension to the double yellow lines south of the junction with Grooms Drive, behind the existing school keep clear markings up to the edge of the zig-zag markings for the zebra crossing.

CAREW ROAD, NORTHWOOD - Convert the existing single yellow line across the entrance to Chestnut Court to double yellow lines.

WOOD LANE, RUISLIP - Propose double yellow lines west of the eastern most junction with Chichester Avenue up to the edge of the bus stop.

ADDISON WAY, HAYES - Proposed double yellow lines at the junction with Manor Road.

MANOR ROAD, HAYES - Proposed double yellow lines at the junction with Addison Way.

COLNE AVENUE, WEST DRAYTON - On the outside of the junction with Lawn Avenue.

LAWN AVENUE, WEST DRAYTON - On the outside of the junction with Colne Avenue.

YORK AVENUE, HAYES - At the junction with Judge Heath Lane.

JUDGE HEATH LANE, HAYES - At the junction with York Avenue.

BEECHWOOD AVENUE, HAYES - At the junction with Botwell Common Road.

BOTWELL COMMON ROAD, HAYES - At the junction with Beechwood Avenue.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed installation of waiting and loading restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety.


The proposed removal of part of the permit holder parking place outside No. 12 Cornwall Road, Uxbridge is intended to provide clear access to a new off-street parking area.


