- vii)Outside No. 13 Westbourne Road, Hayes
- viii) Outside No. 11 Raeburn Road, Hayes
- ix) Outside No. 261 Coldharbour Lane, Hayes

- xi) Outside No. 9 Albert Road, West Drayton
- xii)Outside No. 8 Mount Pleasant, Harefield

SCHEDULE 1 - Proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions

BOTWELL LANE, HAYES

- i) Extend the existing double yellow lines on the northeast side of Botwell Lane from the junction with Church Road to outside No. 22 Botwell Lane.
- ii) On the southwest side of Botwell Lane from the junction with Church Road up to the start of the disable bay outside No. 45 Botwell Lane.

BROADWATER GARDENS, HAREFIELD - At the junction with Hinkley Close

HINKLEY CLOSE, HAREFIELD - At the junction with Broadwater Gardens

BOLDMERE ROAD, EASTCOTE - At the junction with Chandos Road.

CHANDOS ROAD, EASTCOTE - At the junction with Boldmere Road.

CHICHESTER AVENUE, RUISLIP - Extend the existing double yellow lines southeast of the junction with Seaford Close by 3.6 metres.

COLUMBIA AVENUE, EASTCOTE - On all sides of the junction adjacent to Nos. 22 and 39 Columbia Avenue.

CORONATION ROAD, HAYES - At the junction with Roseville Road. ROSEVILLE ROAD, HAYES

- i) At the junction with Coronation Road.
- ii) Outside Nos. 79 and 81 Roseville Road.

DAWLEY AVENUE, HAYES - At the junction with West Drayton Road.

ELMBRIDGE DRIVE, EASTCOTE - At the junction with River Close.

RIVER CLOSE, EASTCOTE - At the junction with Elmbridge Drive.

FELLOWES CLOSE, HAYES - Opposite Nos. 13 to 16 Fellowes Close.

GORSE WALK. YIEWSLEY - At the junction with Lowdell Close.

LOWDELL CLOSE, YIEWSLEY - At the junction with Gorse Walk.

HAMILTON ROAD, HAYES - On the southwest side of the road near the junction with Hughes Road.

HUGHES ROAD, HAYES - On the northwest side of the road, southwest of the junction with Hamilton Road.

HUNTERS GROVE, HAYES - Extend the existing double yellow lines outside No. 82 Hunters Grove by 11.2 metres.

LOTHIAN AVENUE, HAYES - Across the entrance of the parking area outside Nos. 60a, 60b, 62a and 62b Lothian Avenue.

VICTORIA ROAD, RUISLIP - Either side of the entrance of the access road adjacent to No. 514 Victoria Road.

ST PETERS ROAD, UXBRIDGE - On the inside of the corner next to No. 75 St Peters Road. GERRARD GARDENS, PINNER - On the inside of the corner next to No. 2 Gerrard Gardens. DEANE WAY, EASTCOTE - On the corner outside No. 111 Hawthorne Avenue and Nos. 45 and 47 Deane Way.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed disabled parking bays are intended to benefit disabled people by providing parking bays for the sole use of "blue badge" holders. Redundant bays will be removed to provide more parking for residents and their visitors.

The proposed installation of waiting and loading restrictions are intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.
