Proposed removal of part of the Zone U5 permit holder parking place outside No. 59 Manor Waye, Uxbridge to facilitate the installation of new vehicle crossing. Replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.

SCHEDULE 1 - Proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions

BEDWELL GARDENS, HAYES - Extend the existing double yellow lines northeast of the junction of Croyde Avenue outside Nos. 1 to 11 Bedwell Gardens.

BREAKSPEAR ROAD, RUISLIP - Install double yellow line across and adjacent to the entrance leading to Hopson House and Brills Cottage.

CLOSEMEAD CLOSE, NORTHWOOD - Install double yellow lines on the inside of the corner adjacent to Nos. 26 to 30 Closemead Close.

FIELD END ROAD, RUISLIP -

- i) Install double yellow lines on both sides of the road between the junction of Whitby Road, southeastwards up to the existing restrictions next to bridge over the Yeading Brook.
- ii) Install double yellow lines on both sides of the junction within the service road adjacent to No. 323 Long Drive.

LONG DRIVE, RUISLIP - Install double yellow lines at the junction with the service road fronting Field End Road.

NELSON CLOSE, HILLINGDON - Install double yellow lines at the junction with Nelson Road. NELSON ROAD, HILLINGDON - Install double yellow lines at the junction with Nelson Close. OAK GROVE, RUISLIP - Install double yellow lines on all sides of the junction with Beech Avenue. BEECH AVENUE, RUISLIP - Install double yellow lines on all sides of the junction with Oak Grove. SHAKESPEARE AVENUE, HAYES - Extend the existing double yellow lines near the junction with Yeading Lane outside No. 257 Shakespeare Avenue.

THE DINGLE, HILLINDON - Install double yellow lines on the inside of the corner outside No. 12 The Dingle.


STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed installation of waiting restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.

The proposed formal footway parking scheme is intended to improve parking provisions and maintain access for emergency services and residents in the northern section of Bedford Avenue.


The proposed removal of the permit holder parking place in Hudson Road, Harlington is intended to prevent vehicles from causing an obstruction to off-street parking.


The proposed removal of part of the permit holder parking place outside No. 59 Manor Waye, Uxbridge is intended to provide clear access to a newly create off-street parking area.





