STATION ROAD, HAYES

The east side

1. From a point 8.0 metres north of the common boundary of Nos. 39 & 41 Station Road, to a point 18.0 metres north of the northeastern kerbline of the northwest to southeast arm of Crown Close.

2. From a point 19.0 metres south of the southwestern kerbline of the northwest to southeast arm of Crown Close to a point in line with the northeastern kerbline of Western View.

The west side


1. From a point 2.9 metres north of the southern flankwall of No. 22 Station Road, to a point 3.6 metres south of the northern flankwall of No. 28 Station Road.

2. From a point 34.2 metres south of the northern flankwall of No. 28 Station Road, to a point 1.0 metres south of the northern flankwall of No. 42a Station Road.


3. From a point 6.0 metres south of the northern flankwall of No. 42a Station Road, to a point in line with the southern flankwall of No. 62 Station Road.


