SECTION 90 OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will:

- 1. Create pay & display parking bays operational 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' in Crown Close, Hayes replacing sections of existing double yellow lines.
- 2. Convert the four disabled parking bays on Botwell Lane, Hayes (near the pelican crossing close to the junction with Central Avenue) to pay & display parking bays operational 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm'.
- 3. Impose 'at any time' loading restrictions along the following sections of Coldharbour Lane, Hayes:
  - i) On the existing double yellow lines along both sides of the road near to Nos. 1 to 21 Coldharbour Lane.
  - ii) On the existing double yellow lines opposite the junction with Fairdale Gardens, Hayes.
  - iii) On the existing double yellow lines opposite the junction with Hunters Grove, Hayes.
- 4. Impose 'at any time' loading restriction on Crown Close, Hayes near the junction with Station Road, Hayes.
- 5. Install raised road tables 75 mm high with 1:20 gradient ramps on each approach at the following locations:
  - i) Station Road, Hayes Between Nos. 40/42 and Nos. 39/45.
  - ii) Crown Close, Hayes At the junction with Station Road.
  - iii) Crown Close, Hayes At the junction with Pump Lane.
  - iv) Crown Close, Hayes In line with the southwestern flank wall of Civic Hall car park.
- v) Crown Close, Hayes In line with the common boundary of Nos. 53/55 Station Road and Aguis House.
