- 3. Extend the existing 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions in Redford Way, Uxbridge on the corner next to the church by 10 metres southeastwards.
- 4. Reinstate the previously removed Zone IC permit holder parking place outside No. 30 Milton Court, Ickenham.

## STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1. There is no pedestrian crossing on the service road and passengers in particular wheelchair/pushchair users are forces to walk along a narrow footpath to find the nearest crossing point. The proposals to remove a parking place outside Nos. 1270 and 1272 Uxbridge Road is intended to improve accessibility for disabled bus users.
- 2. The formalised parking outside Nos. 825 to 851 Uxbridge Road will improve Road Safety will encourage vehicles to park parallel to the kerb instead of diagonally.
- 3. The extension of double yellow lines in Redford Way, Uxbridge are intended to prevent obstructive parking and promote road safety.
- 4. The proposed reinstatement of the Zone IC parking place outside No. 30 Milton Court will provide an additional parking space for residents and their visitors.
