- 2. Revise the layout of the parking places in Station Road, Hayes between the junctions of Coldharbour Lane and Crown Close as follows:
 - i) Introduce Pay & Display parking bays operational 'Monday to Saturday 9am to 6.30pm' outside and opposite Nos. 28 to 36 Station Road with 'Monday to Saturday 6am to 9am' waiting restrictions within these spaces.
 - ii) Introduce a loading bay outside Nos. 20/22 Station Road.
 - iii) Introduce disabled parking bays outside No. 38 Station Road and opposite No. 22/28 Station Road.
 - iv) Introduce a motorcycle parking place outside No. 42/42a Station Road.
 - v) Introduce 'at any time' waiting restriction throughout this section of Station Road not mentioned above with 'at any time' loading restrictions at the junction with Crown Close.
- 3. Remove the three Pay & Display parking bays in Hunters Grove, Hayes adjacent to No. 104 Coldharbour Lane, replace with 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions.
- 4. Introduce a new motorcycle parking place outside No. 23 Coldharbour Lane, Hayes.
- 5. Relocate the two brown badge bays from outside Nos. 46 and 48 Coldharbour Lane, Hayes to outside No. 38 and Brotherhood Court Coldharbour Lane, Hayes.
