THE HILLINGDON (SPEED LIMIT) (NO.) TRAFFIC ORDER 2016

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions on sections of road as set out in the Schedule to this notice below.
- 2. Impose 'Monday to Friday 7am to 10am and 4pm to 7pm' waiting restrictions on the section of Harlington Road, Uxbridge between the junctions of Southfield Close and Lees Road.
- 3. Impose 'Monday to Friday 11am to Midday and 2pm to 3pm' waiting restrictions on the following section of Glenalla Road, Ruislip Northeast side, from a point 10 metres northwest of the northwestern kerbline of West Hatch Manor northwestwards for a distance of 27.9 metres.
- **4.** Impose 'Monday to Friday 10am to 11am and 2pm to 3pm' waiting restrictions on the following section of Lawson Gardens, Pinner Southeast side, from a point in line with the northeastern flank wall of No 3 Lawson Gardens northeastwards to a point opposite a point in line with the southeastern boundary of No 21 Lawson Gardens.
- 5. Impose 'Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm' waiting restrictions on the following section of Colham Green Road, Hillingdon Northeast side, from a point 10 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Moorcroft Lane southeastwards to a point opposite a point 10 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Beechwood Avenue.
- 6. Extend the existing footway parking place outside No. 937 Uxbridge Road westwards so that the total bay length is extended to 20 metres.
- 7. Install new disabled parking bays outside:
 - i) No. 49 Shaldon Drive, Ruislip
 - ii) No. 41 St Giles Avenue, Ickenham (bay proposed in Lawrence Drive)
 - iii) No. 183 Grosvenor Avenue, Hayes
 - iv) No. 178 Rowan Road, West Drayton
 - v) No. 18 Westbourne Close, Hayes
 - vi) No. 393 Harlington Road, Uxbridge
 - vii) No. 62 Heath Road, Uxbridge
 - viii) No. 10 Silverdale Gardens, Haves
- 8. Install raised road tables with a maximum height of 75mm and a 1:15 gradient at the following locations on Cheney Street, Pinner:
 - i) Outside No. 42 Cheney Street.
 - ii) Outside No. 27 Cheney Street.
 - iii) Outside No. 23 Cheney Street.
 - iv) On the junction with Bridle Road.
- 9. Install a raised road table on Sipson Lane with a maximum height of 75mm and a 1:20 gradient on each approach 22 metres west of No. 2 Westfield Cottages.
- 10. Reduce the speed limit from 40mph to 30mph on the section of Sipson Lane, Harlington from a point 2 metres west of the western boundary of No. 2 Westfield Cottages to a point 20 metres west of that point.
- 11. Introduce a 20mph Zone on the section of Royal Lane, Hillingdon between the junctions of Pield Heath Road and Uxbridge Road including Old School Road, Rutherford Close and Stilwell Drive. Install raised road tables with a maximum height of 75mm and a 1:15 1:20 gradient at the following locations:
 - i) Between Nos. 123 & 123B Royal Lane.
 - ii) Outside No. 129 Royal Lane.
 - iii) Approximately 20 metres north of the junction with Kirby Way.
 - iv) Approximately 50 metres north of the junction with Kirby Way.
 - v) Approximately 10 metres northwest of the junction with Colham Road.
 - vi) Approximately 40 metres southeast of the junction with Robinwood Grove.

- vii) The existing zebra crossing at the southernmost vehicular access to Bishopshalt School.
- viii) Approximately 170 metres south of The Chantry.
- ix) Approximately 80 metres south of The Chantry.

SCHEDULE - NO WAITING 'AT ANY TIME'

DAWLEY PARADE, HAYES - At the junctions with Dawley Road, Hayes.

DAWLEY ROAD, HAYES - At the junctions with Dawley Parade, Hayes.

GARDEN CLOSE, RUISLIP - At the junction with Eversley Crescent, Ruislip.

EVERSLEY CRESCENT, RUISLIP - At the junction with Garden Close, Ruislip.

PRINTINGHOUSE LANE, HAYES - Southeast side, from a point 3 metres southwest of the common boundary of Nos. 23 and 24 Printinghouse Lane southwestwards to a point 43 metres northeast of the edge of the Grand Union Canal towpath excluding the lay-by.

HUNTERS GROVE, HAYES - The junction opposite Crossway, Hayes.

COTTAGE CLOSE, RUISLIP - At the junction with Sharps Lanes, Ruislip.

SHARPS LANE, RUISLIP - At the junction with Cottage Close, Ruislip.

GROSVENOR AVENUE, HAYES - On the corner outside Nos. 172 to 188 Grosvenor Avenue, Hayes.

KINGSHILL AVENUE, HAYES - At the junction with Bradenham Road, Hayes.

BRADENHAM ROAD, HAYES - At the junction with Kingshill Avenue, Hayes.

YEADING GARDENS, HAYES - At the junction with Selan Gardens, Hayes.

SELAN GARDENS, HAYES - At the junction with Yeading Gardens, Hayes.

GLENALLA ROAD, RUISLIP - Southwest side, from a point 10 metres northwest of the northwestern kerbline of West Hatch Manor northwestwards for a distance of 25.7 metres. HARLINGTON ROAD, UXBRIDGE

- i) At the junction of the main access road leading to Harlington Road Depot.
- ii) At the junction of the southern access road leading to Harlington Road Depot.

LOTHIAN AVENUE, HAYES - At the junction of Yeading Lane.

YEADING LANE, HAYES - At the junction of Lothian Avenue.

STOCKELY CLOSE, YIEWSLEY (The north to south arm)

- i) West side, from the northern kerbline of the east-west arm of Stockley Close, northwards for a distance of 25 metres.
- ii) The east, north, west and southern sides of the northern most section of the north to south arm. from a point 4.7 metres south a point in line with the northernmost wall of No.364 Stockley Close, to the extent of the adopted highway.

WHITETHORNE AVENUE, YIEWSLEY - Extend the existing restrictions on the northwest side near the junction with Yew Avenue.

BRAUNSTON ROAD, HAYES - At the junction with Broadmead Road. BROADMEAD ROAD, HAYES

- i) Northwest side, between the Borough Boundary and the junction with the Berrydale Road.
- ii) Southeast side, opposite the junction with Berrydale Road.
- iii) Southeast side, opposite the junction with Braunston Road.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed installation of waiting restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety.

The proposals to introduce disabled parking bays are intended to benefit disabled people by providing a parking bay for the sole use of "blue badge" holders.


The proposed 20mph zone and raised tables are intended to reduce vehicle speeds and improve road safety in Royal Lane, Hillingdon.

The proposed raised tables are intended to enhance road safety on Cheney Street without effecting emergency services, whilst improving the safety of pedestrians.


The proposed raised table and change of speed limit are intended enhance road safety on Sipson Lane without effecting the emergency services, whilst improving the safety of pedestrians.

The proposed footway parking changes outside No. 937 Uxbridge Road will provide additional parking for residents and their visitors.

All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.








Proposed Extension to Footway Parking Uxbridge Road, Hayes


