Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:

- 1) Proposed extension to the operational times of the Uxbridge South Parking Management Scheme Zone U6 in Cobden Close, Uxbridge to 'Monday to Friday 8am to 8pm'.
- 2) Proposed inclusion of the off-street parking areas in Cobden Close, Uxbridge into the Uxbridge South Parking Management Scheme Zone U6.
- 3) Proposed introduction of a 7.5 tonne weight restriction except for access in Bridge Road, Tachbrook Road, Austin Waye, Wescott Way, Bettles Close, Glebe Road and Fray's Waye, Uxbridge.
- 4) Proposed introduction of a 7.5 tonne weight limit and 7 foot width restriction across Swan Bridge, Cowley Mill Road, Uxbridge.
- 5) Proposed introduction of a 20mph speed limit in Glebe Road and Wescott Way, Uxbridge.
- 6) Establish footway parking places in which a vehicle may park with two wheels 0.5 metres on the footway in the southern section of Knoll Crescent, Northwood.
- 7) Revise the proposals previously advertised on the 29th April 2015 to introduce a Parking Management Scheme in Frays Avenue, West Drayton as follows:
 - i) Reduce the length of the previously proposed permit holder parking place outside No. 18 Frays Avenue by 1.5 metres and replace with 'Monday to Friday 10am and Midday' waiting restrictions.
 - ii) Remove the previously proposed permit holder parking place outside Nos. 31 & 33 Frays Avenue and replace with 'Monday to Friday 10am and Midday' waiting restrictions.

STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposals for Cobden Close are in direct response to a petition and informal consultation with residents. The proposals will restore the balance of parking in favour of local residents.

The proposed 20mph speed limit, width and weight restrictions are intended to enhance the road safety and the ambiance for local residents, especially those wishing to walk and cycle in the area. The measures are proposed in response to two recent petitions submitted by local residents as well as a public hearing.

The proposed footway parking scheme in part of Knolls Crescent is intended to remove obstructive parking to improve road safety and promote the free flow of traffic.


The proposed amendments for to the previously proposed Parking Management Scheme in Frays Avenue will enable residents to maximise the benefits of the parking scheme.
