Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions as set out in the Schedule of this notice.
- 2. Propose the following amendments to the proposed extension to the Northwood Parking Management Scheme:
 - i) The removal of the previously proposed single yellow line adjacent the private garages and car park next to No. 4 Cygnet Close, Northwood to be replaced with a residents' permit parking place.
 - ii) The reduction of the previously proposed permit parking place outside No. 34 Duck's Hill Road, Northwood by 11 metres, to be replaced with 'at any time' waiting restrictions
- 3. Remove the Zone SR permit holder parking place outside No. 2 Dudley Drive, South Ruislip and replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restriction.
- 4. Install new disabled parking bays at the following locations:
 - i) Outside Nos. 17/18 Clarkes Drive, Uxbridge
 - ii) Outside Nos.65/66 Berkeley Close, Ruislip
 - iii) Outside No. 47 Westwood Close, Ruislip
- 5. Convert part of the Zone U5 permit holder parking place outside No. 36 & 38 Walford Road, Uxbridge to a disabled parking bay.
- 6. Impose 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions on the southern corner of the junction of Bury Avenue and Goshawk Gardens, Hayes.

SCHEDULE WAITING PROHIBITED 'AT ANY TIME'

EAST WALK, HAYES - Along both sides of the entire road.

ORWELL CLOSE, HAYES - Along both sides of the road from the junction with Botwell Common Road to opposite the flats.

BOTWELL COMMON ROAD, HAYES - At the junction of Orwell Close.

STATEMENT OF REASONS


(Bury Avenue and Goshawk Gardens proposals) - Parked vehicles outside the library restrict bus movements. The proposed waiting and loading restrictions are to allow buses to adequately access the stop and deploy a ramp when required. This is intended to improve accessibility for disabled bus users.


(East Walk, Orwell Close and Botwell Common Road proposals) - The proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions are intended to remove obstructive parking to improve road safety and promote the free flow of traffic.


(Proposals relating to disabled bays) - The proposed disabled parking bay is intended to benefit disabled people by providing a parking bay for the sole use of "blue badge" holders. The reduction in the length of the existing double yellow lines will not compromise road safety.

(Dudley Drive proposal) - The proposed removal of the permit holder parking place will prevent obstruction to this soon to be constructed vehicle crossing.


