  - **iv) Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions** along sections of Old Orchard Close, Uxbridge to prevent obstructive parking.
- 2. Proposed extension to the Ruislip Parking Management Scheme Zone R2 in part of Hill Lane, Ruislip
  - i) Establish permit parking places (operational between '9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid R2 permit in the section of Hill Lane, Ruislip between the junctions with Sharps Lane and Orchard Close.
  - **ii) Impose waiting restrictions** in the section of Hill Lane, Ruislip between the junctions of Sharps Lane and Orchard Close operational between '9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday'.
  - **iii) Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions at the junction of Hill Lane and Sharps Lane** to prevent obstructive parking on the junction.


#### STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposed removal of part of a residents parking bay on Austin Waye will improve road safety.


The proposed restrictions on West Drayton Park Avenue will stop non-residential and obstructive parking.
