Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Extend the existing 20mph Zone on Laurel Lane, West Drayton from the junction with Berberis Walk to the junction with Rowan Road.**
- 2. Impose a 20mph Zone on Rowan Road, West Drayton between the western most junction with Great Bentley to and a point in line with the common Nos. 166 and 168 Rowan Road.**
- 3. Install raised road tables with a maximum height of 100mm and a 1:20 gradient at the following locations:**
 - i) At the junction of Rowan Road and Laurel Lane, West Drayton
 - ii) Outside Nos. 22-26 Laurel Lane, West Drayton
 - iii) Outside No. 156 Rowan Road, West Drayton
 - iv) At eastern most junction of Rowan Road and Wise Lane, West Drayton
- 4. Install a new bus lay-by outside Nos. 2 to 14 Laurel Lane, West Drayton.**
- 5. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of road as set out in the Schedule to this notice.**

SCHEDULE - NO WAITING 'AT ANY TIME'

LAUREL LANE, WEST DRAYTON - Both sides, from a point in line with the northeastern kerbline of Rowan Road, northeastwards for a distance of 14 metres.

ROWAN ROAD, WEST DRAYTON

- i) Northwest side, between a point 13 metres southwest of the southwestern kerbline of the eastern most junction of Wise Lane and a point opposite a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 156 and 158 Rowan Road.
- ii) Southeast side, from a point opposite a point 13 metres southwest of the southwestern kerbline of the eastern most junction of Wise Lane, northeastwards for a distance of 23.8 metres.
- iii) Southeast side, from a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 150 and 152 Rowan Road, northeastwards for a distance of 33.2 metres.
- iv) Both sides, from a point in line with the northwestern flank wall of No. 162 Rowan Road, southeastwards for a distance of 27.8 metres.

WISE LANE, WEST DRAYTON - Both sides, from a point in line with the northwestern kerbline of the southeastern most northeast to southwest arm of Rowan Road, northwestwards for a distance of 11.8 metres.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed improvements near Laurel Lane Primary School will improve pedestrian safety, provide better bus accessibility and promote road safety.

Northwest side,

- i) From a point 5.1 metres northeast of the common boundary of Nos. 20 and 22 High Street, northeastwards for a distance of 9.3 metres.
- ii) From a point 3.5 metres southwest of the common boundary of Nos. 22 and 24 High Street, southwestwards for a distance of 12.4 metres.
- iii) From a point 2.8 metres southwest of the common boundary of Nos. 30 and 32 High Street, southwestwards for a distance of 42.8 metres.

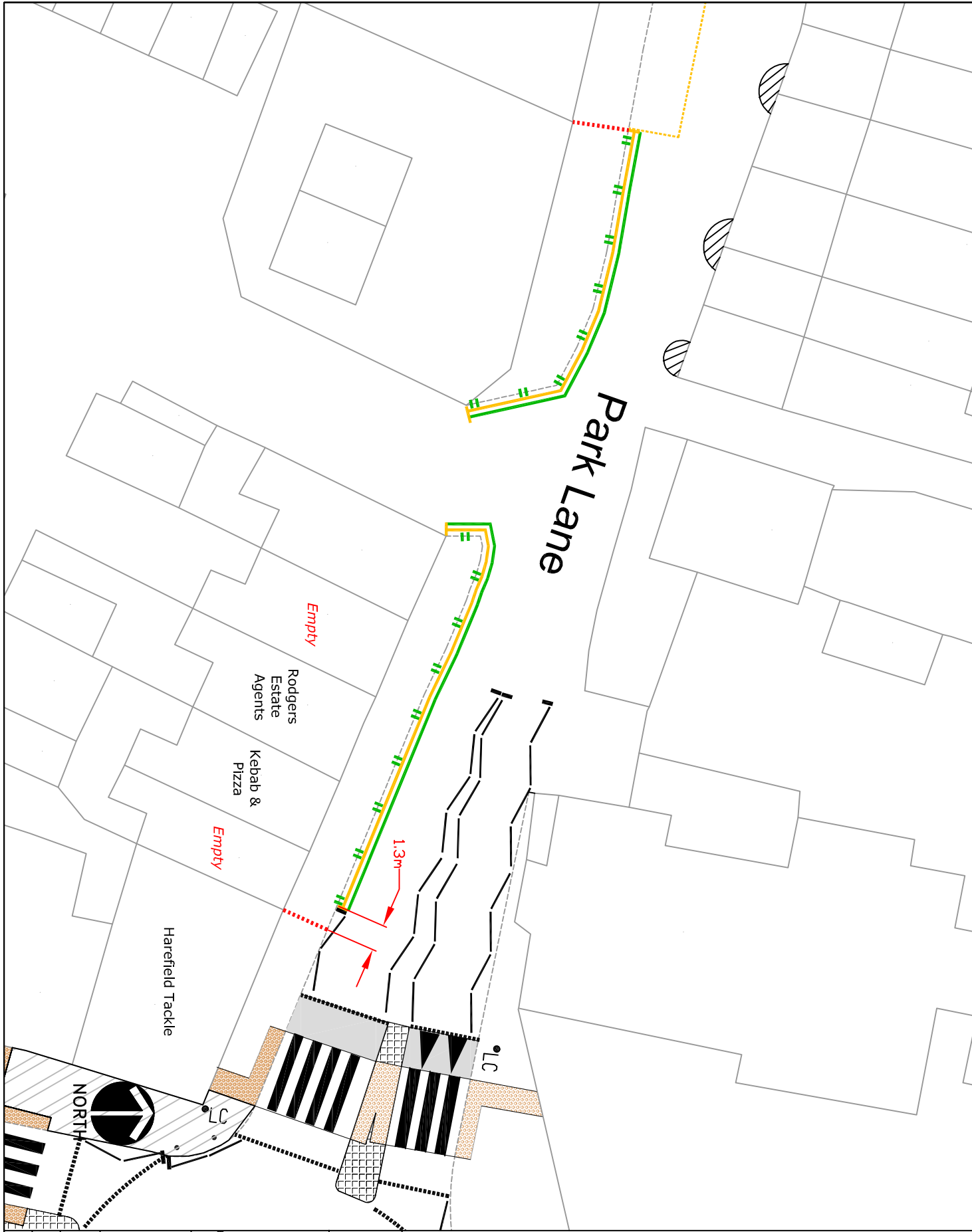
Southeast side,

WESTWOOD CLOSE, RUISLIP

- i) The northeast to southwest arm southeast of Nos. 43 to 47 Westwood Close -
From a point 2.3 metres southwest of the common boundary of Nos. 46 and 47 Westwood Close, northeastwards to the northeastern extremity returning on the northeast side to a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 44 and 45 Westwood Close.
- ii) The northeast to southwest arm southeast of Nos. 67 to 71 Westwood Close,
From a point 1.3 metres northeast of the southwestern boundary of No. 67 Westwood Close, northeastwards to the northeastern extremity returning on the northeast side to a point 7.5 metres southwest of the common boundary of Nos. 69 and 70 Westwood Close.
- iii) Northwest side, from a point 10 metres southwest of the southwestern kerbline of Ladygate Lane southwestwards for a distance of 31 metres.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This proposed waiting restriction will stop obstructive parking and improve road safety. Therefore it is recommended to commence statutory consultation to introduce waiting restrictions in Westwood Close.
