- 4. Impose waiting restrictions in Frays Avenue, West Drayton operational between 10am and Midday Monday to Friday with sections of 'at any time' waiting restrictions at the junction with Lawn Avenue and on the section of road outside Nos. 21 to 26 Fray's Avenue.

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Establish permit parking places (operational between '8.30am and 5pm Monday to Friday') in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone Y2 permit in Gordon Road, Yiewsley.
- 2. Impose waiting restrictions in Gordon Road, Yiewsley operational between '8.30am and 5pm Monday to Friday' with 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions in the turning head opposite Nos. 20 and 22 Gordon Road.
- 3. Convert the operational times of the Zone Y1 Parking Management Scheme in Colham Avenue, Yiewsley to '9am to 5pm Monday to Friday'.

- 6. Replace the existing Zone Y1 permit holder parking place on the northeast side of Tavistock Road, Yiewsley between the junctions of Heathcote Way and Padcroft Road with 'Midday to 1pm Monday to Friday' waiting restrictions.
- 7. Extend the existing Zone Y1 permit holder parking place opposite Nos. 1 and 2 Padcroft Road, Yiewsley northeastwards by a distance of 1 metre.
