- 4. Convert the following section of existing 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restriction to 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the following section of Rockingham Close, Uxbridge Northeast, south and southwest sides between a point 10 metres south of the southern kerbline of Redfern Close and the cul-de-sac turning area of Rockingham Close, returning on the southwest side to a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 18 and 20 Rockingham Close.
- 5. Convert the following section of existing 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' waiting restriction to 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the following section of Cowley Road, Uxbridge East and southeast sides from a point in line with the common boundary of Wellington House and Cochrane House southwards to a point 1 metre south of the northern flank wall of No 18 Cowley Road.

AYLSHAM DRIVE, RUISLIP - Eastern most northeast to southwest arm, southeast and southwest sides, from a point 5.6 metres northeast of the southwestern flank wall of Nos. 259 to 329 Aylsham Drive, southwestwards and northwestwards to a point in line with the northwestern boundary of No. 335 Aylsham Drive.

MANNINGTREE ROAD, RUISLIP - Both sides, from the southwestern kerbline of Victoria Road southwestwards for a distance of 10 metres.





STATEMENT OF REASONS



PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT SCHEME HARMONDSWORTH ROAD, WEST DRAYTON Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:


- 1. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the following section of Harmondsworth Road west side, from a point in line with the southwestern kerbline of Sipson Road, southwards to a point in line with the north kerbline of the entrance of the service road fronting Nos. 1-19 (odds) Harmondsworth Road.
- 2.  - i) At the northern entrance of service road fronting Nos. 23-29 (odds) Harmondsworth Road.
 - ii) Laurel Lane
 - iii) Rowlheys Place
 - iv) Coleridge Way
- 5. Install a new zebra crossing on Harmondsworth Road north of the junction with Laurel Lane and south of the northern entrance of service road fronting Nos. 23-29 (odds) Harmondsworth Road.



 - iv. At the junction with East Way and Minet Drive
- 8. Convert the following sections of footway to shared use for pedestrians and cyclists:
 - i. Coldharbour Lane, Hayes between the junctions of Minet Drive and Station Road.
 - ii. Station Road, Hayes between the junctions of Coldharbour Lane and Western View.


