AMENDMENTS TO THE UXBRIDGE PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME, WAITING RESTRICTIONS & CHANGES TO THE FOOTWAY PARKING SCHEME IN CORWELL LANE Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the lengths of road set out in the Schedule to this notice.
- 2. Remove a section of 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm' waiting restrictions outside No. 5 Fairlight Drive, Uxbridge.
- 3. Remove a section of Zone U5 permit holder parking place outside No. 126 Manor Waye, Uxbridge, replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restriction.
- 4. Amend the previously proposed footway parking scheme in Corwell Lane, Hayes as follows:
 - i) Propose additional footway parking outside Nos. 72 & 74
 - ii) Remove the previously proposed parking places outside No. 27 and outside No.58
- 5. Remove the existing 'Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm' waiting restrictions in Brearley Close, Uxbridge.
- 6. Impose permit holder only parking (operational between 10.00am and 8.30pm everyday) in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone U9 permit in Brearley Close, Uxbridge.

RESIDENTS PERMITS - £0 - 1st vehicle, all subsequent - £40 per annum

VISITORS VOUCHERS First book of 10 per household per annum- free. £5 - per book of 10 thereafter.

SCHEDULE - WAITING PROHIBITED 'AT ANY TIME'

APPLE TREE AVENUE, HILLINGDON - East side, from a point opposite a point in line with the northern boundary of No. 27 Violet Avenue, to a point opposite a point 10 metres south of the southern kerbline of the western most east to west arm of Violet Avenue.

VIOLET AVENUE, HILLINGDON - Both sides, from a point in line with the eastern kerbline of Apple Tree Avenue, eastwards for a distance of 17.3 metres.

HILL LANE, RUISLIP- Northwest side, from a point 15.3 metres southwest of the southwestern kerbline of Orchard Close and a point 12 metres northeast of the northeastern kerbline of Orchard Close.

ORCHARD CLOSE, RUISLIP

- i) Northeast side, from a point in line with the northwestern kerbline of Hill Lane and a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 19 and 2 Orchard Close.
- ii) Southwest side, from a point in line with the northwestern kerbline of Hill Lane and a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 21 and 23 Hill Lane.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed waiting restrictions are intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been signed off by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.

The proposals to remove part of the parking place outside No. 126 Manor Waye will prevent obstruction to a soon to be constructed vehicle crossing.

The proposal to remove a section of waiting restrictions outside No. 5 Fairlight Drive will allow residents to continue to use their private parking bays without future risk of receiving a Penalty Charge Notice for parking on a waiting restriction.

The proposed permit holder parking scheme in Brearley Close will prevent all day nonresidential parking whilst still providing parking provision for residents and their visitors.
