Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions** on the lengths of road set out in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- 2. Install footway parking places** on the lengths of Paget Road set out in Schedule 2 to this notice.

SCHEDULE 1 - WAITING PROHIBITED 'AT ANY TIME'

HARMONDSWORTH LANE, SIPSON

- i) South side, from a point opposite a point 2.5 metres west of the eastern flank wall of No. 44 Harmondsworth Lane, westwards for a distance of 76.4 metres.
- ii) Both sides, from a point 163.3 metres west of the western boundary of No. 46 Harmondsworth Lane, westwards for a distance of 30 metres.

PAGET ROAD, HILLINGDON

Southeast side, from a point in line with the northeastern kerbline of the service road fronting No. 1390 Uxbridge Road to No. 1 Addiscombe Court Uxbridge Road, to a point 16.2 metres northeast of the northeastern kerbline of De Salis Road.

UXBRIDGE ROAD, HILLINGDON

(Service road fronting No. 1390 Uxbridge Road to No. 1 Addiscombe Court)

Both sides, from a point 10 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Paget Road to a point 10 metres northwest of the northwestern kerbline of Paget Road.

SCHEDULE 2 - PROPOSED FOOTWAY PARKING PLACES IN PAGET ROAD, HILLINGDON

Northwest side

- i) From a point in line with the common boundary of Nos.14 and 15 Paget Road, northeastwards for a distance of 16.2 metres.
- ii) From a point 0.5 metres southwest of the common boundary of Nos. 20 and 21 Paget Road, southwestwards for a distance of 14.2 metres.


Southeast side

- i) From a point 3.6 metres southwest of the southwestern flank wall of No.30 Paget Road, southwestwards for a distance of 8.4 metres.
- ii) From a point 1.9 metres northeast of the southwestern flank wall of No.30 Paget Road, northeastwards for a distance of 13.7 metres.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed changes will stop obstructive and all day parking within the affected roads. All proposals have been agreed by the Cabinet Member for Planning, Transportation and Recycling to proceed to formal consultation.



1) Make the following amendments to the Heathrow Parking Management (Zone H1):

- i) Extend the operational times of the Heathrow Parking Management Scheme in Heath Close from Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm to Monday to Saturday 9am to 8pm.
- ii) Change the shared use parking places in Pondsides Close and Gilpin Way, Harlington to permit holders only.

2) Reduce the operational times of the West Drayton Parking Management Scheme (Zone WD2) in Brickfields Way, West Drayton from 9am to 10pm everyday to Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm.

3) Extend the operational times of the Uxbridge South Parking Management Scheme (Zone U5) in Nursery Way so that the scheme will start from 8am instead of 9am.



STATEMENT OF REASONS








