AMENDMENTS AND PROPOSED EXTENSION OF THE ICKENHAM PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will:

- 1. Make the following amendments to the previously proposed scheme advertised on 27th November 2013:
 - i) Defer the proposed introduction of an extension to the Ickenham Parking Management scheme in Neela Close, instead it is proposed to install a 'Monday to Friday 10am to 11am' waiting restriction throughout the road.
 - ii) Extend the proposed double yellow lines on the north side of Crosier Road from the junction with Glebe Avenue up to the northeastern boundary of No. 47 Glebe Avenue.
 - iii) Extend the existing double yellow lines on the southeast side of Ivy House Road from the junction with Almond Avenue to outside No. 15 Ivy House Road.
 - iv) Extend the proposed double yellow lines on Milton Road west of the junction with Ivy House Road on both sides of the road up to the entrance of the access road leading to Heath House.
 - v) Convert a section of previously proposed double yellow lines outside No. 23 Milton Road to Monday to Friday 11am to Midday waiting restriction.
 - vi) Propose an additional permit parking place outside Nos.23-33 Pepys Close.
 - vii) Extend the previously proposed permit parking place outside Nos. 63-77 Pepys Close.
- 2. Propose to install 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the following sections of Long Lane:
 - i) Between the junctions of Milton Road and Court Road
 - ii) At the junction with Gilbey Close.
 - iii) From the southern end of the service road fronting Nos. 21-59 odd Long Lane to a point 30 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Edinburgh Drive.
- 3. Propose to install 'Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm' waiting restrictions outside Nos. 72-76 Long Lane
- **4.** Install a 50 metre long Bus Stand in the main carriageway of Long Lane outside Nos. 47-53 Long Lane, operational Monday to Friday 2pm to 4pm.
- **5. Install new bus stop cages and clearways** at the existing bus stops outside Douay Martyrs School and outside Nos. 62 and 64 Long Lane.
- **6.** Propose to remove the existing parking place outside Nos. 40 Rectory Way, Ickenham and replace with Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm waiting restriction.
- **7. Propose a section of Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm waiting restriction** along the southwest side of Copthall Road East between the junctions of Swakeleys Road and Hoylake Crescent.
- **8. Propose 'at any time waiting restrictions** at the junctions of Copthall Road East with Hoylake Crescent and Swakeleys Road.




The proposed amendments to the previously proposed scheme will enable residents to maximise the benefits of the parking scheme.




The proposed removal of the permit holder parking place outside No. 40 Rectory Way is to allow clear access to the off-street parking area opposite.



- ii) North side, from a point in line with the eastern flank wall of the Scouts Hut to a point in line with the eastern kerbline of Community Close.


