- b) Proposed replacement of existing disabled parking bay with two new disabled parking bays in the parking area adjacent to St John the Baptist's Church on Royal Lane, Hillingdon.
- c) Proposed installation of two disabled parking bays on Coldharbour Lane, Hayes outside Hayes Baptist Church.
- d) Formalise the existing disabled parking bays on Kingshill Avenue, Hayes outside the shops.
- e) Proposed extension of the disabled parking place outside No. 9 Radnor Grove, Uxbridge from 5 metres to 6.6 metres in length.
- f) Convert the redundant disabled parking bay opposite No. 31 Ashby Way, Sipson to a Zone H1 permit holder parking place.
- g) Convert the redundant disabled parking bay opposite No. 35 Trevor Crescent, Ruislip to a Zone RG permit holder parking place.
- h) Convert the redundant disabled parking bay outside No. 90 Stafford Road, Ruislip to a Zone RG permit holder parking place.
- i) Remove other redundant disabled parking places from various locations across the Borough. 




STATEMENT OF REASONS



CARNARVON DRIVE, HAYES
