



PROPOSED AMENDMEMTS AND EXTENSION OF THE NORTHWOOD PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will:

- **1. Establish permit parking places** (operational between 8.00am to 10.00am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday) in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone N permit in Hawkesworth Close, Northwood.
- **2. Impose waiting restrictions** in Hawkesworth Close, Northwood operational between 8.00am to 10.00 am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday.
- 3. Change the operational times of Zone N of the Northwood Parking Management Scheme in Maxwell Road (between the junctions of Rickmansworth Road and Anthus Mews), Falcon Close and Dormans Close to Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm.
- **4. Establish permit parking places** (operational between 11.00am and 3.00pm Monday to Friday) in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone N permit in Thirlmere Gardens and Tanworth Close, Northwood.
- **5. Impose waiting restrictions** in Thirlmere Gardens and Tanworth Close, Northwood operational between 11.00am and 3.00pm Monday to Friday.

RESIDENTS PERMITS - £0 - 1st vehicle, all subsequent - £40 per annum

VISITORS VOUCHERS First book of 10 per household per annum- free. £5 - per book of 10 thereafter.
