




## STATEMENT OF REASONS

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will: **1. Establish parking places** operational between 8.00am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday

outside Nos. 240-310 Kingshill Avenue, Hayes.

a) Pay and display bays The maximum period for which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours is two hours, if it displays a valid ticket from a ticket parking machine with the charges shown below.

**b) Disabled Bays** in which only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge may be left at all times outside Nos. 242-244, No. 276 and Nos. 294-298 Kingshill Avenue.

**2. Convert sections of existing single yellow lines to double yellow lines** between Nos. 240-310 Kingshill Avenue, Hayes along the northwest side of the road.

**3. Establish parking places** operational between 8.00am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday along sections of the southwest side of the service road fronting Nos. 1250 to 1362 Uxbridge Road, Hayes.

a) Pay and display bays The maximum period for which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours is two hours, if it displays a valid ticket from a ticket parking machine with the charges shown below.

b) Loading only bay in which a goods vehicle may load or unload for a maximum of 20 minutes opposite Nos. 1330 & 1332 Uxbridge Road in place of existing double yellow lines.
c) Disabled bays in which only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge may be left at all times opposite Nos. 1258-1260, Nos. 1298-1300, Nos. 1306-1308 and Hayes End Library, Uxbridge Road.

**4. Introduce 'at any time' loading restrictions** on the existing double yellow lines on the southwest side of the service road fronting Nos. 1250 to 1362 Uxbridge Road, Hayes opposite the junction with Hayes End Drive.






HARMONDSWORTH LANE – North side, from the western boundary of No. 3 Monks Way, to a point 10 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Monks Way
