AMENDMENTS TO THE PROPOSED EXTENSION TO THE WEST DRAYTON/YIEWSLEY PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME ZONE Y1

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will amend the proposals advertised on 22nd August 2012 to:

- 1. Establish permit parking places in Colham Avenue and Winnock Road (operational between 9am and 6pm Monday to Saturday) in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Y1 permit.
- 2. Impose waiting restrictions in Colham Avenue and Winnock Road operational between 9am and 6pm Monday to Saturday with 'at any time' waiting restrictions near the junctions and along narrow sections of road.
- **3. Impose waiting restrictions** operational between Midday and 1pm Monday to Friday on the following sections of Tavistock Road:
 - i) Northeast side From a point 10 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Winnock Road southeastwards for a distance of 92.6 metres (in place of a previously proposed section of Pay & Display and shared use parking bays).
 - ii) Northeast side From a point 10 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Trout Road, to a point 10 metres northwest of the northwestern kerbline of Heathcote Way.
- **4. Remove the previously proposed disabled bay** on Tavistock Road, replace with an additional Pay & Display bay.
- **5.** Remove an existing Zone Y1 parking place on Bentinck Road outside the new development northwest of Union Wharf, Bentinck Road, replace with Monday to Saturday 9am to 6pm waiting restriction.
- **6. Extend the existing Pay & Display parking place on Bentinck Road** outside Globe House, northwestwards by 15 metres.
- 7. Reduce the existing double yellow lines at the following locations to allow for extensions to proposed permit holder parking places.
 - i) On Bentinck Road near the junctions with Padcroft Road, Wimpole Road and Winnock Road.
 - ii) On Padcroft Road near the junction with Bentinck Road.
 - iii) On Wimpole Road near the junction with Bentinck Road.
- 8. Reduce the proposed double yellow lines on Padcroft Road northeast of the junction with Heathcote Way to 8 metres, replace with Monday to Saturday 9am to 6pm waiting restriction.
