SCHEDULE

KNOLL CRESCENT, NORTHWOOD

Southernmost northwest to southeast arm of Knoll Crescent

Northeast side of Knoll Crescent

From a point 15 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of The Drive for a distance of 5.5 metres southeastwards (0.5 metre on footway)

Southwest side of Knoll Crescent

From a point 38 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of The Drive for a distance of 22 metres southeastwards (0.5 metre on footway)

Southwest side of Knoll Crescent

From a point 1.3 metres southeast of the common boundary of Nos. 135 & 137 Knoll Crescent for a distance of 9.3 metres northwestwards (0.5 metre on footway)

Southernmost northeast to southwest arm of Knoll Crescent

Northwest side of Knoll Crescent

From a point 4 metres southwest of the northeastern flank wall of No. 72 Knoll Crescent for a distance of 10 metres southwestwards (0.5 metre on footway)

Northwest side of Knoll Crescent

From a point in line with the northeastern flank wall of No. 76 Knoll Crescent for a distance of 9 metres southwestwards (0.5 metre on footway)
