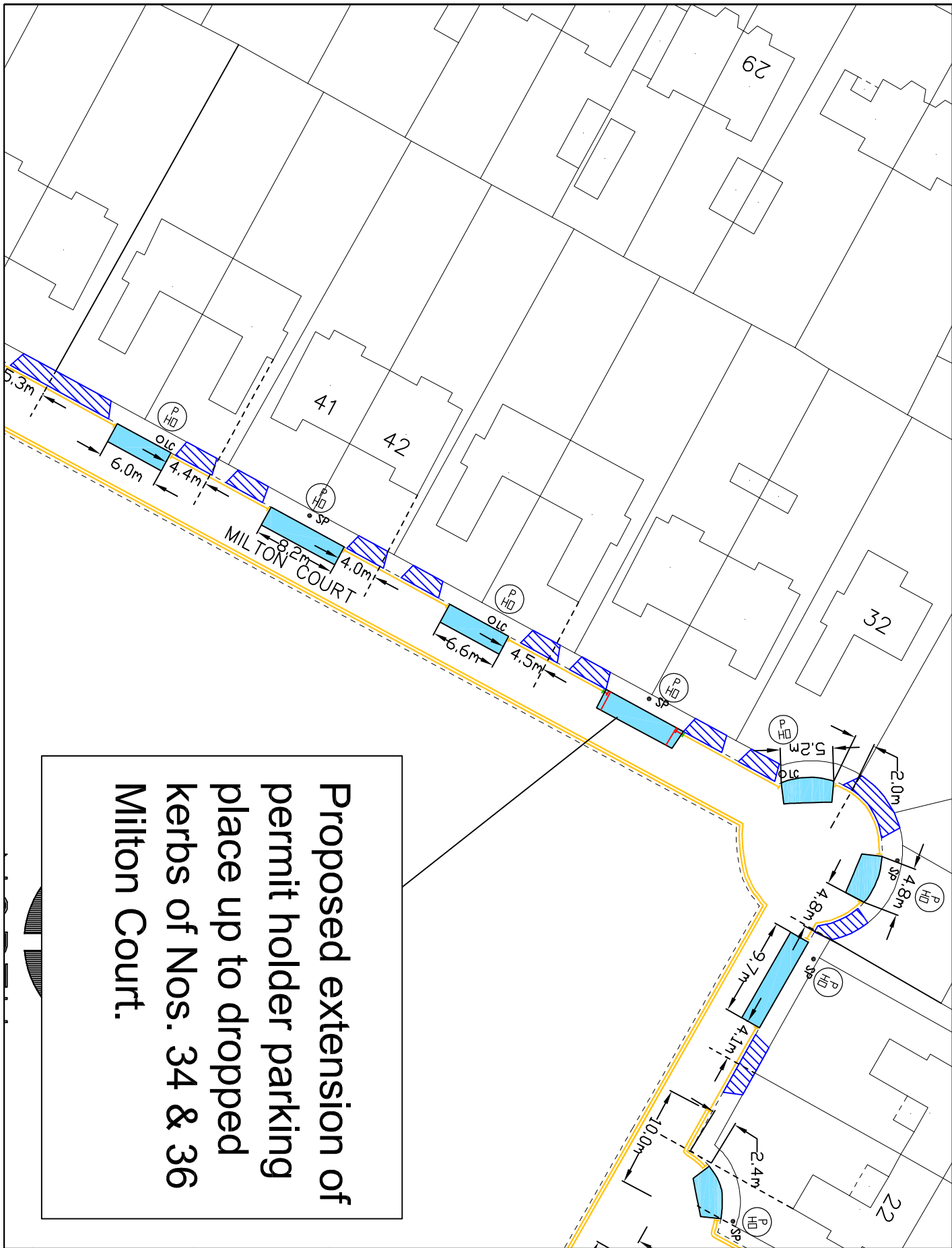

SCHEDULE  
WAITING PROHIBITED 'AT ANY TIME'

WEST END ROAD, RUISLIP - Northeast side, between a point 10 metres north of the northern kerblines of Eversley Crescent and a point 10 metres south of the southern kerblines of Eversley Crescent.

EVERSLEY CRESCENT, RUISLIP – Both sides, from a point in line with the northeastern kerblines of West End Road, northeastwards for a distance of 10 metres.

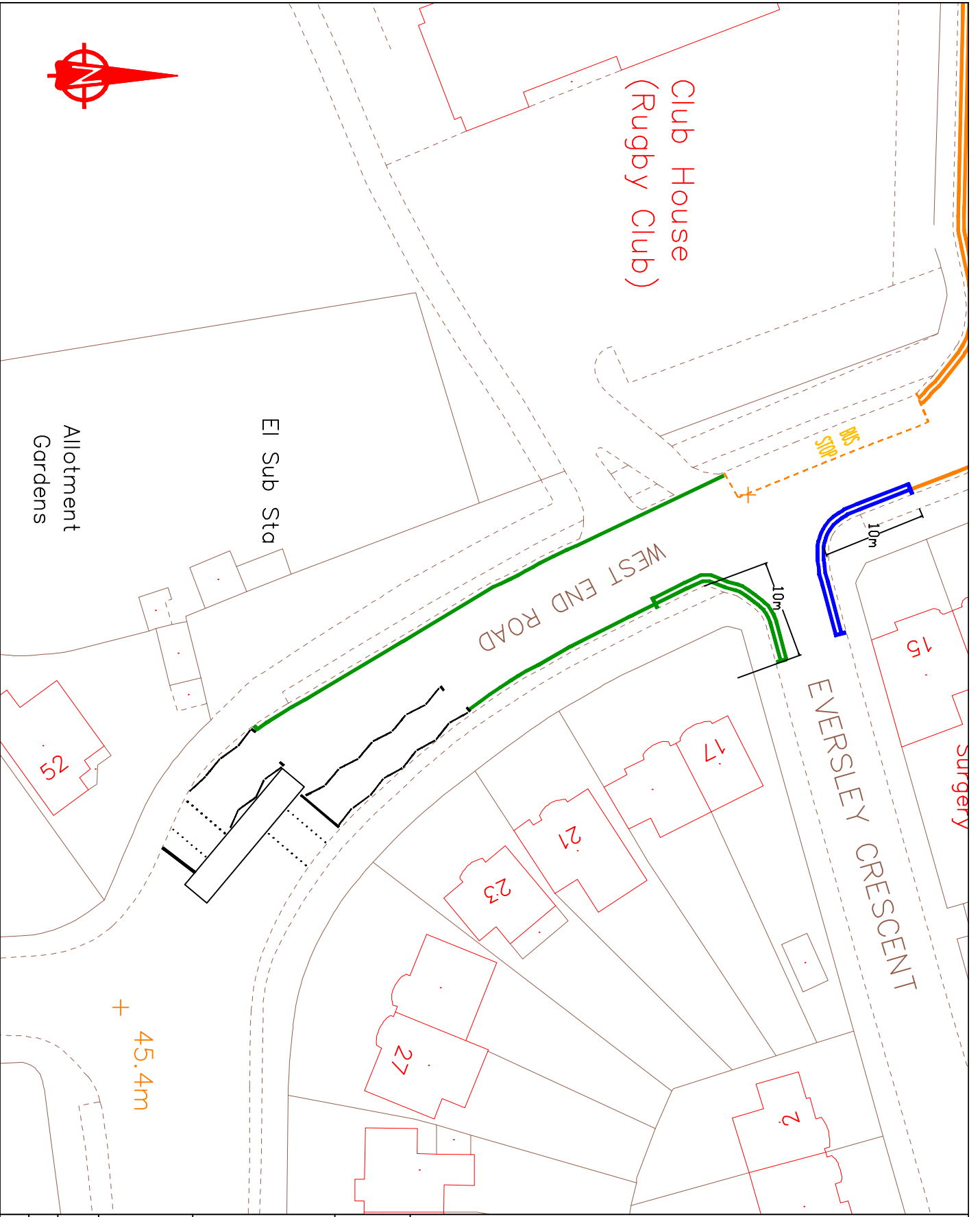
WAITING PROHIBITED 'MONDAY – FRIDAY 8AM – 10AM AND 2.30PM – 4.30PM'

WEST END ROAD, RUISLIP – Northeast side, between a point 10 metres south the southeasterly kerblines of Eversley Crescent and a point 2 metres northwest of the common boundary of Nos. 21 and 23 West End Road.

WEST END ROAD, RUISLIP – Southwest side, between a point opposite a point 0.5 metres northwest of the southeastern kerblines of Eversley Crescent and a point 2 metres northwest of the northern boundary of No. 52 West End Road.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The proposed waiting restrictions are intended to remove obstructive parking to improve road safety.
