THE HILLINGDON (NO.)(SPEED LIMIT)ORDER 2013
SHRUBS ROAD PROPOSED 40MPH SPEED LIMIT

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make this Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to reduce the maximum speed limit from national speed limit to 40 m.p.h. on Shrubs Road from the Borough Boundary with Three Rivers District Council to its junction with Northwood Road.
