AMENDMENTS AND PROPOSED EXTENSION OF THE ICKENHAM PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will:

- 1. Make the following amendments to the previously proposed scheme advertised on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2012:
  - i. The removal of the proposed parking place outside No. 6 Rectory Way.
  - ii. The reduction of the proposed parking place outside Nos. 2 & 4 Rectory Way by 1.3 metres.
  - iii. The reduction of the proposed parking place adjacent to No. 30 Swakeleys Road by 0.3 metres.
  - iv. The removal of the proposed parking place adjacent to No. 2 The Mallows. This section of kerbspace will therefore remain as the prevailing 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6:30pm' restriction.
  - v. The removal of the proposed parking place opposite Nos. 12 & 14 Rectory Way.
  - vi. The reduction of the proposed parking place outside No. 2 Boniface Road by 2 metres, to be replaced with an 'at any time' waiting restriction.
- 2. Establish permit parking places (operational between 9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday) in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid IC permit in roads listed in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- 3. Impose waiting restrictions in roads listed in Schedule 1 to this notice operational between 9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday.
- 4. Impose 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of the roads listed in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- 5. Impose Monday to Friday 10am 11am and 4pm to 5pm waiting restriction along the eastern side of a section of Boniface Road fronting The Buntings.

**RESIDENTS PERMITS** - £0 - 1st vehicle, all subsequent - £40 per annum

**VISITORS VOUCHERS** First book of 10 per household per annum- free. £5 - per book of 10 thereafter.
