Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will:-

1. designate disabled persons parking places, in which vehicles displaying in a relevant position a disabled persons badge issued under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badge for motor vehicles) Regulations 2000 may be left therein. These will be operational at all times In locations already marked, in roads listed in Schedule 1 to this notice;
2. consolidate the existing designated disabled persons parking bays contained in the Hillingdon (Free Parking Places (Disabled Persons ) Traffic Order 2010 and remove those no longer required in roads listed in Schedule 2 to this notice.
3. Amend the On Street Parking Place Orders listed above to install or remove a disabled persons parking place where it is located in a permit parking place.
4. Replace the existing disabled bay located in Delamere Road, Hayes with “at any time” waiting restrictions.

NEWDIGATE ROAD PROPOSED PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it intends to make these Orders, which will:-

1. **Establish permit parking places** (operational between 9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday) in which a vehicle may be left at the permitted hours if it displays a valid permit in roads listed in Schedule 1 to this notice.
2. **Impose waiting restrictions** in roads listed in the Schedule below, operational between 9.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday, with "at any time" restrictions around the junctions.
3. **Impose "at any time" waiting restrictions** on lengths of road as set out in schedule 2 to this notice.

**RESIDENTS PERMITS** - £0 - 1st vehicle, all subsequent - £40 per annum

**VISITORS VOUCHERS** First book of 10 per household per annum- free.

£5 - per book of 10 thereafter.

**a) The northeast and northwest sides.**

- i) from a point 28.0 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Rickmansworth Road, to a point 3.0 metres southeast of the northwestern flank wall of No. 1 Newdigate Road.
- ii) from a point 1.7 metres southeast of the common boundary of Nos. 79 & 79a Newdigate Road, to a point opposite a point in line with the northeastern flank wall of No. 2 Adrian Close.

**b) The southeast, south, and southwest sides,**

- i) from a point 1.0 metre northwest of the southeastern boundary of No. 24 Newdigate Road, to a point in line with the northeastern flank wall of No. 2 Adrian Close.
- ii) from a point 10 metres south east of the southeastern kerbline of Rickmansworth Road to a point opposite a point 12.0 metres northwest of the common boundary of Nos. 13 & 15 Newdigate Road.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The proposals to implement "permit holder only" parking bays operational Monday to Friday 9.00am to 5.00pm is in response to requests from the householders in Newdigate Road to restore the balance of parking in favour of residents as shown on the attached plan.
