Terms and Conditions of the Application to Inter

Period

The London Borough of Hillingdon (the Grantor) grants the gravespace to the named applicant for a period of 100 years.

Benefits and Responsibilities

No memorial may be placed on the grave without the written consent of the named applicant. The installation of any memorial is subject to the approval and issue of a Permit by the London Borough of Hillingdon. The maintenance and insurance of the memorial is the responsibility of the named applicant. If a memorial becomes unsafe or dilapidated and the named applicant fails to take appropriate action within one calendar month of notification, the London Borough of Hillingdon reserves the right to take action to make the memorial safe or to remove and dispose of the memorial. The named applicant may not install another memorial until the costs of any action taken by the London Borough of Hillingdon in regard to the original memorial have been refunded.

Interment application to inter does not grant ownership of the land itself, which remains in the ownership of the London Borough of Hillingdon.

The London Borough of Hillingdon records contain the details of registered named applicants. However, it is the responsibility of each named applicant to keep their Confirmation of Interment certificate safe.

Possession of the Confirmation of Interment does not in itself signify ownership of the gravespace.

During their lifetime, the named applicant may formally assign their application to inter to another person. This should be completed using a Form of Assignment issued by the London Borough of Hillingdon.

Upon the death of the named applicant, their application to inter forms part of their estate and should be formally transferred to the person legally entitled to this. This should be completed using appropriate forms issued by the London Borough of Hillingdon.

Fees

Fees are payable to the London Borough of Hillingdon for the:

- The right to erect a memorial and for any additional work to the memorial
- Transfer of Application to Inter

Restrictions

The Application to Inter may only be exercised in accordance with the London Borough of Hillingdon's Cemetery Regulations. The Cemetery Regulations include restrictions on burials, memorials, access and other matters relating to the cemeteries.
