Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make these Orders which will:

- 1. Install 'at any time' waiting restrictions in sections of roads as set out in the schedule to this notice below.
- 2. Install blue badge disabled parking bays at the following locations:
 - i) Alongside No. 12 School Road, Harmondsworth
 - ii) Outside No. 51 Portland Road, Hayes
 - iii) Outside No. 103 Cleave Avenue, Hayes
 - iv) Outside No. 19 25 Petworth Gardens, Hillingdon
 - v) Outside No. 67 St Peters Road, Cowley
 - vi) Outside No. 11 Sylvana Close, Hillingdon
 - vii) Outside No. 30-33 Hornbill Close, Cowley
 - viii) Outside No. 108 Dulverton Road, Ruislip
- 3. Convert the existing Zone U5 permit holder parking place outside No 2-3 Nursery Waye, Uxbridge to a blue badge disabled parking bay.
- 4. Remove the following redundant blue badge disabled parking bays:
 - i) Outside No. 50 Kenilworth Gardens, Hayes
 - ii) On Dartmouth Road, alongside No. 328 Victoria Road, Ruislip
 - iii) Outside No. 102 Pine Gardens, Ruislip
 - iv) Outside No. 68 Monmouth Road, Hayes
 - v) Outside No. 53 Portland Road, Hayes
- 5. Convert the redundant blue badge disabled parking bay outside No. 6 Preston Court, York Road, Northwood Hills to Zone NWH permit holder parking place.
- **6.** Reduce the length of the existing Zone SR permit holder parking place opposite No. 1 Weldon Close, Ruislip by 1 metre. Replace with 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions. 


STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposed installation of waiting restrictions is intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Planning and Transportation to proceed to formal consultation.




The proposed amendments in Weldon Close are intended to ensure clear access can be maintained to an adjacent off-street parking area that already exists.
























RESIDENT PERMIT HOLDERS PARKING PLACES - ZONE SR

Parking places in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone SR permit or visitor voucher. All parking places are 2 metres wide unless otherwise stated.
