Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1897 by architect William Howard Seth-Smith. Built as a large private residence for Miss M A Bevan. Red brick, now pebble dashed on first floor, tiled roof. Attractive brick chimney stacks. Elevations made interesting by half timbered gables, eaves details and dormers. Brick porch entrance, with simple pillars. Extended and converted to flats in 1962 (now forming flats 10-11).

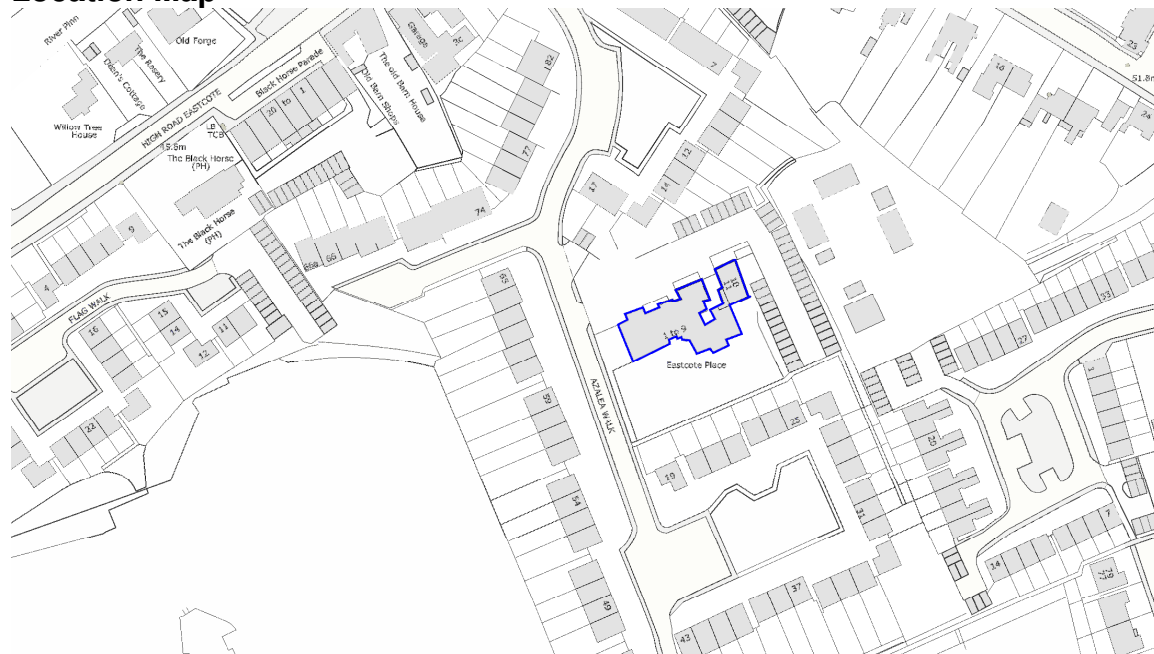
Townscape: Contributes to local character.

Historical: Used as an operations room in WW II. Allied carrier command post set up in April 1944, mainly used as telephonic co-ordination centre.
