Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation			
<p><u>Architectural</u>: Group of four pairs of similar designed Victorian villas. Each pair two storeys, one or two windows wide. Low pitched hipped slated roofs, some renewed. Nos 8-10 originally in red brick, No 8 has been pebble-dashed. Two storey extensions on each side, set back from front elevation. Nos 12-14 rendered with slate roofs and full height bays. Nos 16-22 in painted brick with single storey ground floor bay windows. These retain stained glass panels above the front doors. Nos 20-22 in stock brick, with render door and window surrounds.</p> <p><u>Townscape</u>: Contribute to local character. Group value within the Eastcote Village Conservation Area.</p> <p><u>Historical</u>: Built for William Lawrence, local farmer.</p>
