




<p>Photograph</p> 	<p>Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation</p> <p><u>Architectural</u>: C1870. Good example of an estate worker's cottage. Two storey in stock brick with red and black brick banding, tiled roof with exposed chimney breasts to each side. Prominent gabled dormers on the first floor, with herringbone brick work in red and black. Polychromatic arches over ground floor windows.</p> <p><u>Townscape</u>: Contributes to local character.</p> <p><u>Historical</u>: Originally called Homeside. Built for Lawrence James Baker, who owned the local Haydon Hall Estate from 1864.</p>
