Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: C1870, fine pair of ornamental wrought iron gates.

Townscape: Forms a dramatic entrance to the park.

Historical: Made originally for the entrance to the galleries of art dealers Thomas, Agnew & Sons (New Bond Street). Later acquired by the Eastcote Association and erected at the newly opened Eastcote Recreation Ground, now known as Warrender Park.
