**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

Architectural: Built as 3 cottages circa 1880, originally known as Southill Cottages, by Architects Ernest George and Peto. Two storey with three prominent gables. Brick with decorative tile hanging to upper storeys. Tiled roof and prominent chimneys.

Townscape: Picturesque setting. Contributes to local character.

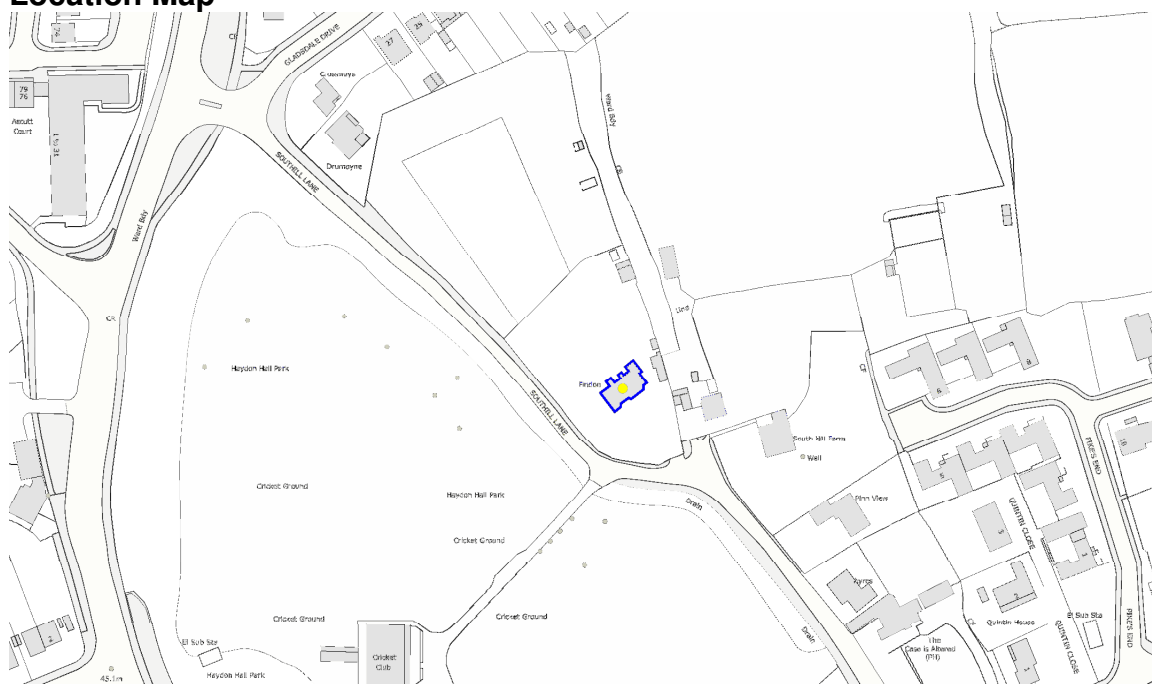
Historical: Built to house workers of the Haydon Hall Estate.
