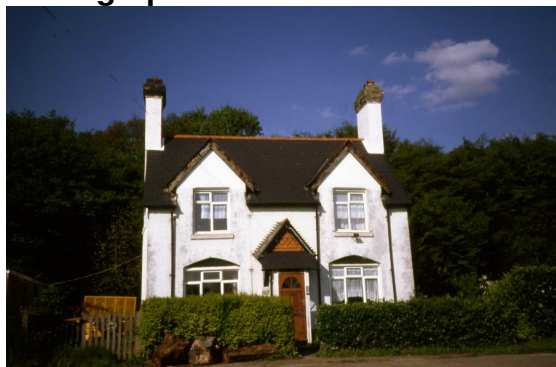

**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

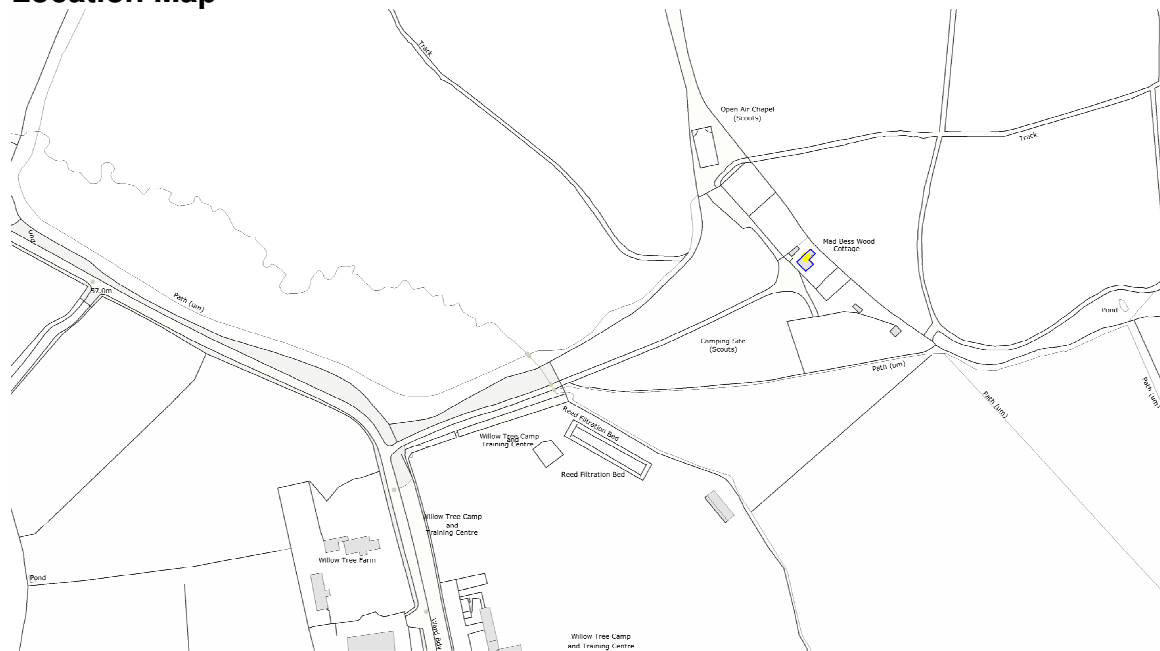
Architectural: Two storey Victorian lodge, two gabled half dormers over first floor windows and symmetrical gable end chimneys. Polychrome brick (now painted white). Tiled roof.

Townscape: Contributes to local character.

Historical: Built as a Keeper's Cottage by L.J. Baker of Haydon Hall c1875. He owned the woodland 1873-83.
