


Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1884, replaced an earlier building which was burnt down. Simple building, yellow stock brick with tiled roof. Gable fronting Hatch Lane with deep barge boards. Later gabled porch addition with similar detailing. Brick quoin detail. Arched window heads. Circular window in gable end over front elevation. Elevation fronting High Street: single storey, flat roof, with elongated window frames.

<u>Townscape</u>: Contributes to the local character and street scene.
